1216hw Men's Handwarmers



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Soupir Wool Chuboso [53% merino wool, 31% acrylic, 15% tencel, 1% silk;
157 yds/144m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #06 camel brown, 2 skeins [45g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- palm circumference 20cm/7.87"
- length 17cm/6.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 22 sts and 30.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Each handwarmer is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Handwarmer: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and pattern stitch. BO in pattern. Make second handwarmer as reverse image of first.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other, seam sides of each handwarmer with mattress stitch, leaving opening for thumbs unseamed (see finishing schematic).

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off


C4F = slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front; k2; k2 from cable needle

CO = cast on


k = knit

p = purl
