

216aw-02 Leather Strap Cami



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Elmer [80% wool, 20% silk; 175 yds/160m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #09 royal violet, 4 skeins [140g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- 2 leather straps (15mm/0.59" x 26cm/10.24")

Finished measurements:

- bust 91cm/35.83"
- back length (excluding shoulder straps) 47.5cm/18.70"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 25 sts and 35 rows
- pattern stitch A: 29 sts and 35 rows
- pattern stitch B: 25 sts and 36 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

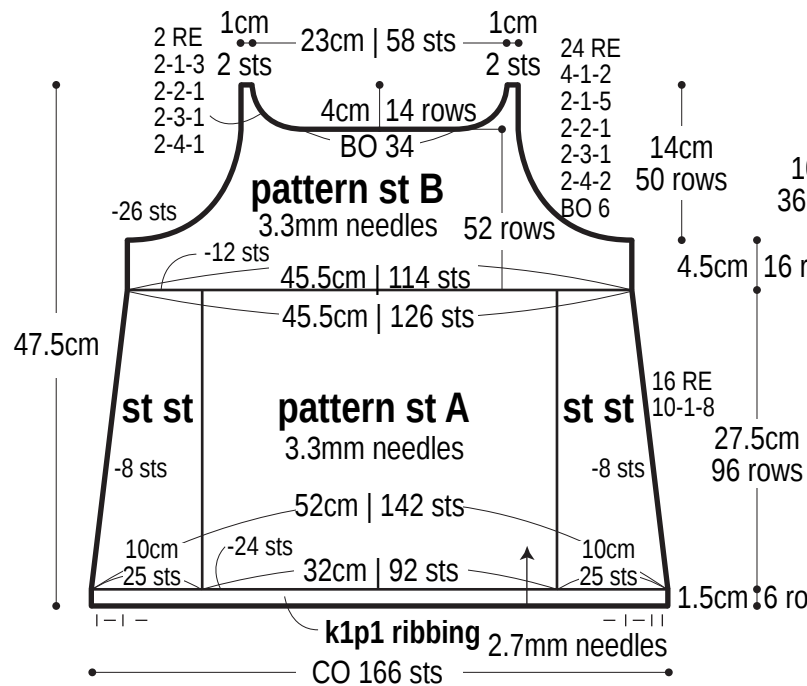
Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, stockinette stitch, and pattern stitch A according to schematic. Continue in pattern stitch B.

Finishing: Seam sides with mattress stitch. Work sc edging around neckline. Work sc edging around armholes. Fasten leather straps to garment where indicated. (Punch holes in each end of leather strap if necessary.)

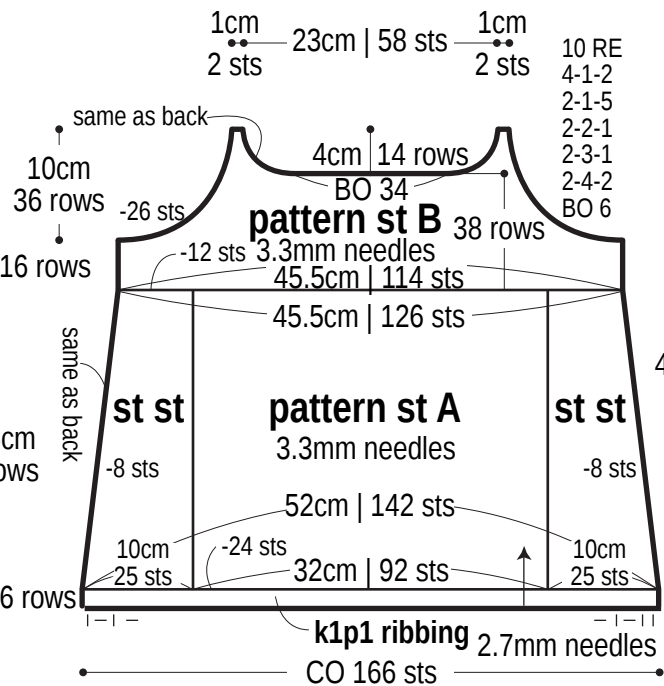
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl RE = row(s) even sc = single crochet (US) st st = stockinette stitch #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

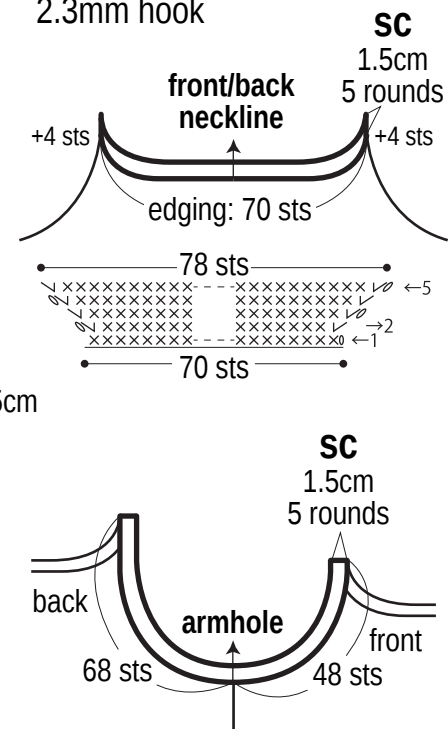

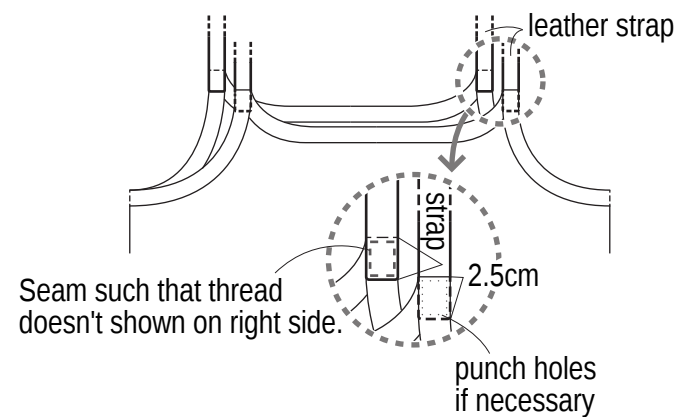
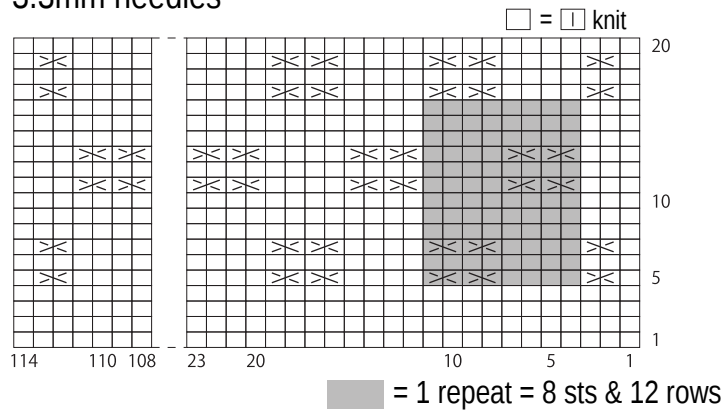
Finishing

2.3mm hook



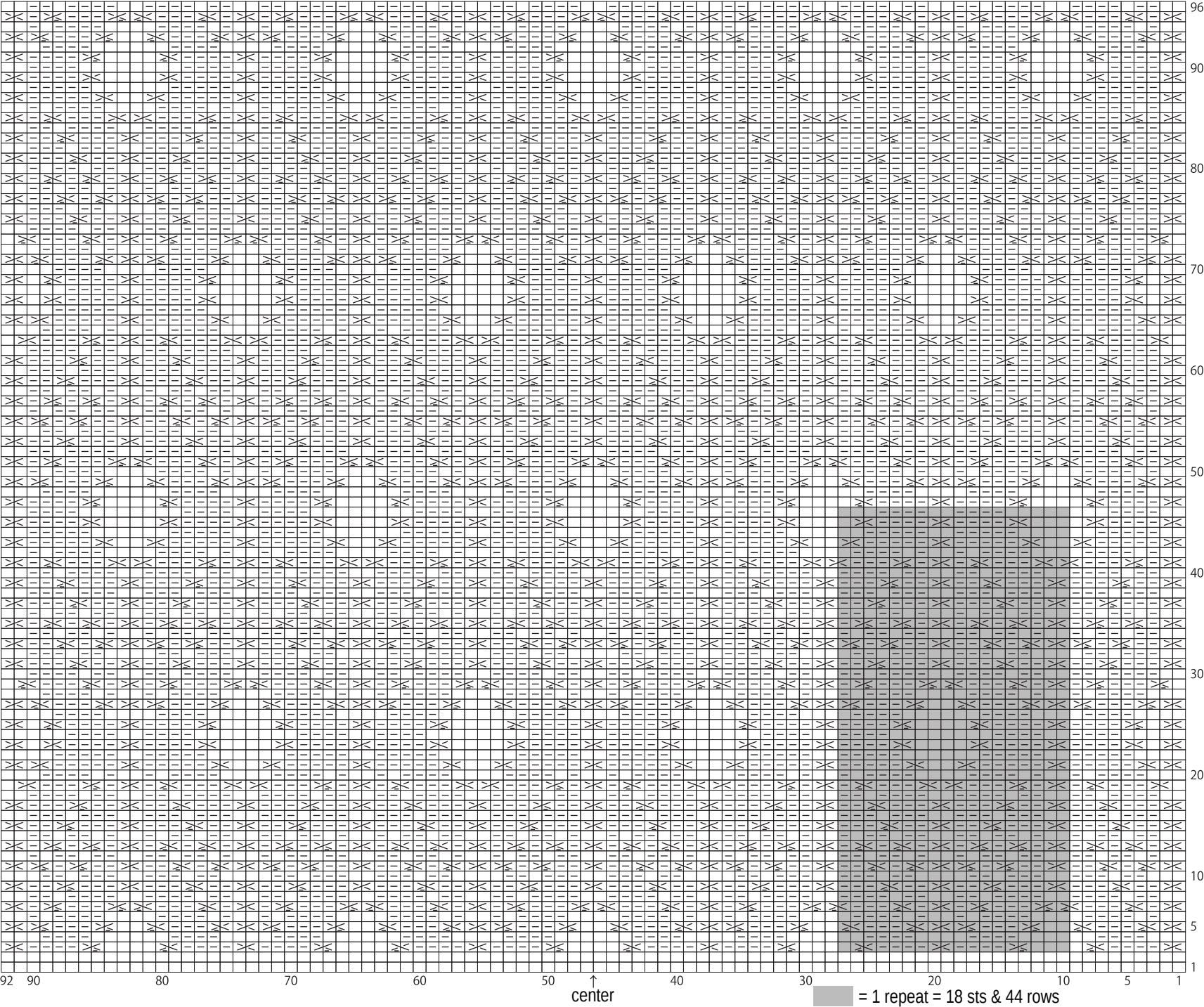
Pattern stitch B
