

# 217ss-13 Pattern Stitch Cardigan



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Neox [60% ramie, 25% silk, 15% rayon; 112 yds/102m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #01 platinum white, 1 skein [35g]
  - color #02 luxury gray, 1 skein [30g]
  - color #03 gloss black, 4 skeins [145g]
  - color #05 royal blue, 6 skeins [230g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (15mm/0.59")

## Finished measurements:

- chest 102cm/40.16"
- cross back width 41cm/16.14"
- back length 64cm/25.20"
- sleeve length 63cm/24.80"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 23 sts and 28 rows
- seed stitch: 23 sts and 28 rows
- pattern stitch: 25 sts and 29 rows
- k1p1 ribbing (with 3.0mm needles): 26 sts and 40 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

## Summary

**Back:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch. Shape neckline by binding off stitches as indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases (1 st in from the edge) as indicated.

**Front (make 2):** Cast on as for back. Work in k1p1 ribbing, seed stitch, pattern stitch, and stockinette stitch. Shape neckline by binding off stitches as indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases (1 st in from the edge) as indicated.


**Sleeve (make 2):** Cast on as for back. Work in stockinette stitch, increasing at edges with lifted increases (worked 1 st in from the edge).

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Align parts marked with ★ and seam with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side of body). Pick up stitches around neckline and front edges; work k1p1 ribbing. Bind off.



BO = bind off    CO = cast on    k = knit    p = purl    PU = pick up    RE = row(s) even    st st = stockinette stitch    #-#-# = rows-stitches-times



# Right front










# Chart 1: Right front 3.6mm needles

□ = □ knit


■ = 1 repeat
