

217ss-12 Crew Neck Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat (S) [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - small: color #17 citron green, 12 skeins [455g]
 - large: color #17 citron green, 13 skeins [520g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 24 sts and 33 rows
- pattern stitch B: 23 sts and 31 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back & Front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st, then k1p1 ribbing, then pattern stitch A, and then pattern stitch B.

Sleeve (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st, then k1p1 ribbing, then pattern stitch B.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing and st st, then BO. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch, seaming first 2.5cm/0.98" from hem with right sides facing each other (so that seam will not show where hem rolls). Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

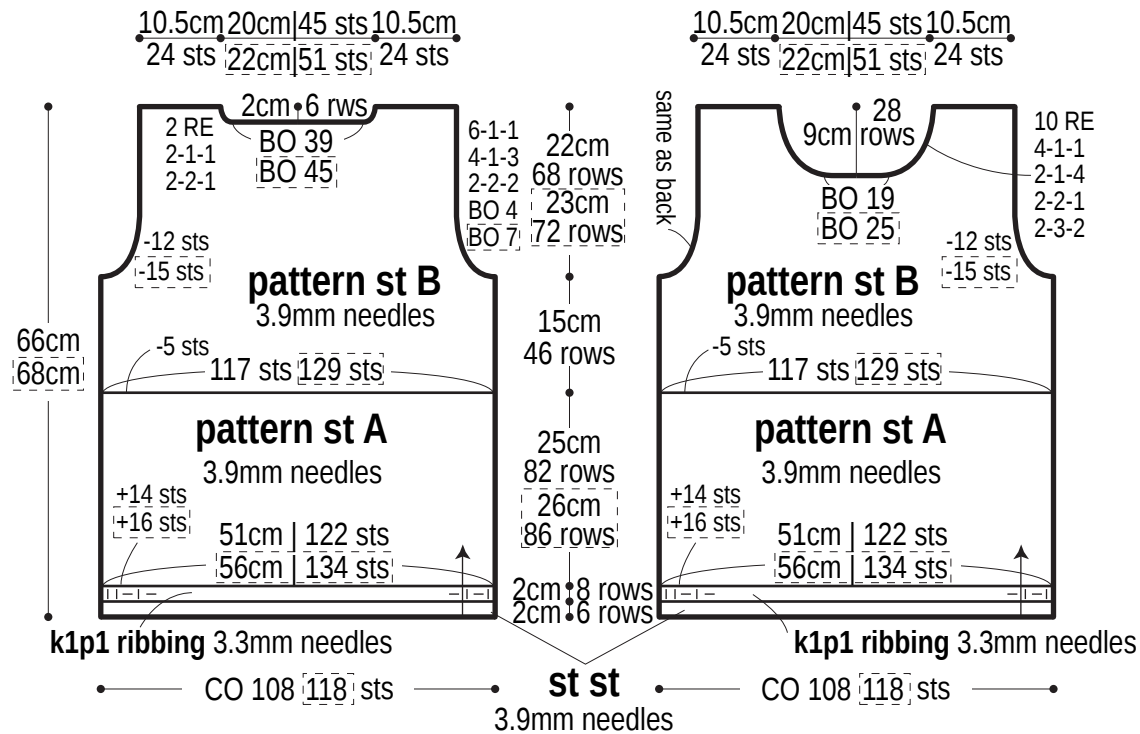
BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even st st = stockinette stitch #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

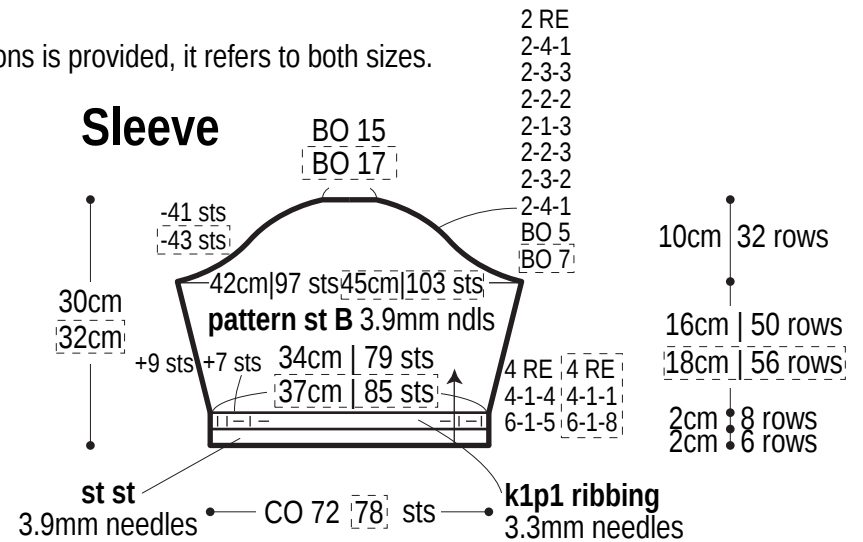

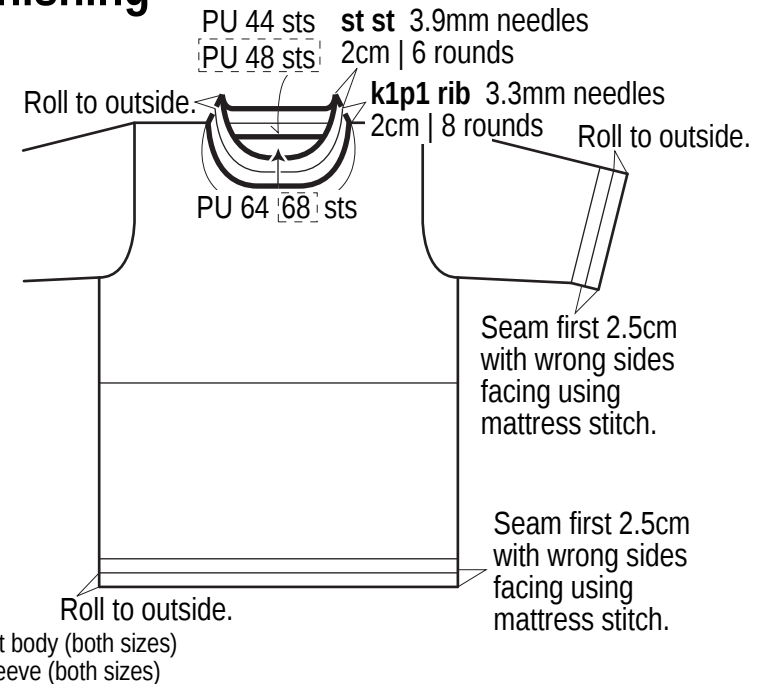

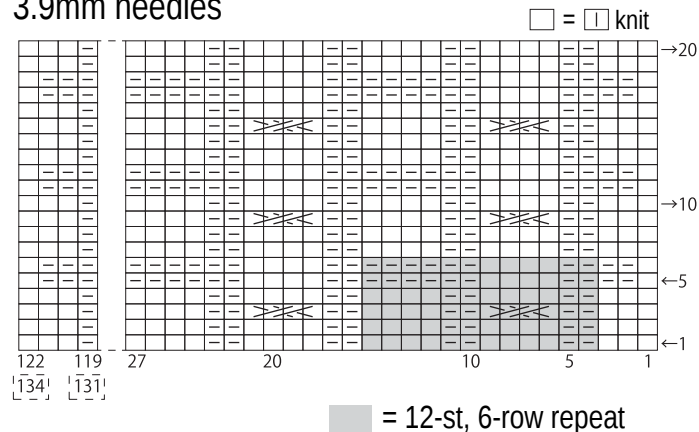
