

tricot10-2 Knit Cap



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Sheep's Walk [53% wool, 35% polyester, 12% nylon; 71 yds/65m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #04 grassland, 2 skeins [75g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 48cm/18.90"
- depth 20cm/7.87"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 20 sts and 25 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 17.5 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round. Work in k1p1 ribbing and pattern stitch in the round. After working 35 rounds, work evenly spaced decreases on round 36. When finished, cut yarn tail and thread through remaining 39 sts twice to cinch shut.

Finishing: Make one pom-pom 5cm/1.97" in diameter. Fasten to top of hat.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

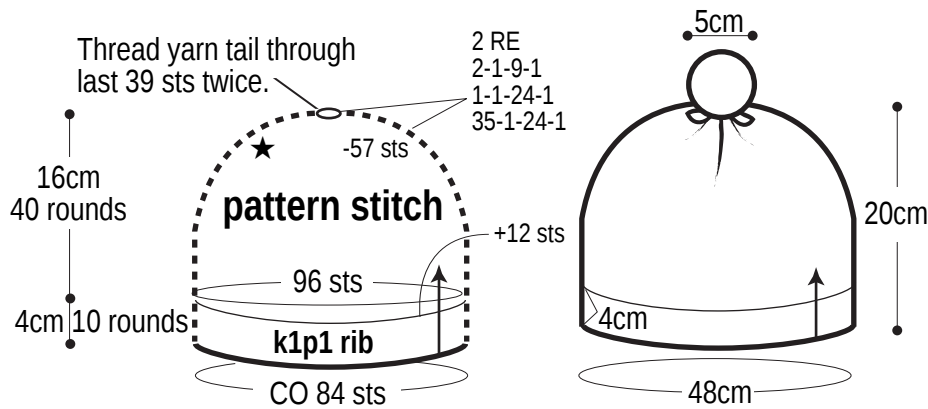
k = knit

p = purl

RE = round(s) even

#-#-#-# = rounds-stitches-places-times [for evenly spaced decreases across entire width item]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 round, decrease 2 stitches in each of 3 places across the round; do this 4 times total."

Hat 4.5mm needles

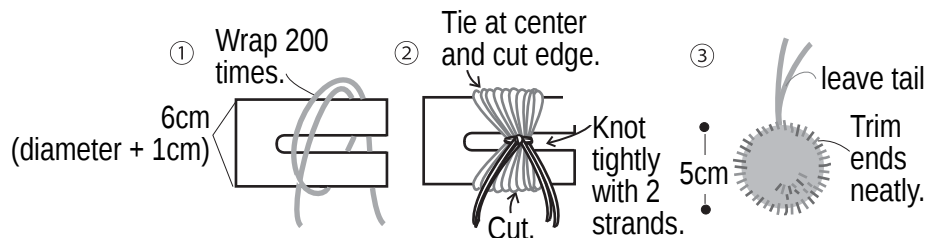


★ = work evenly spaced decreases (see chart)

= pattern stitch

Wrap 2 times clockwise.

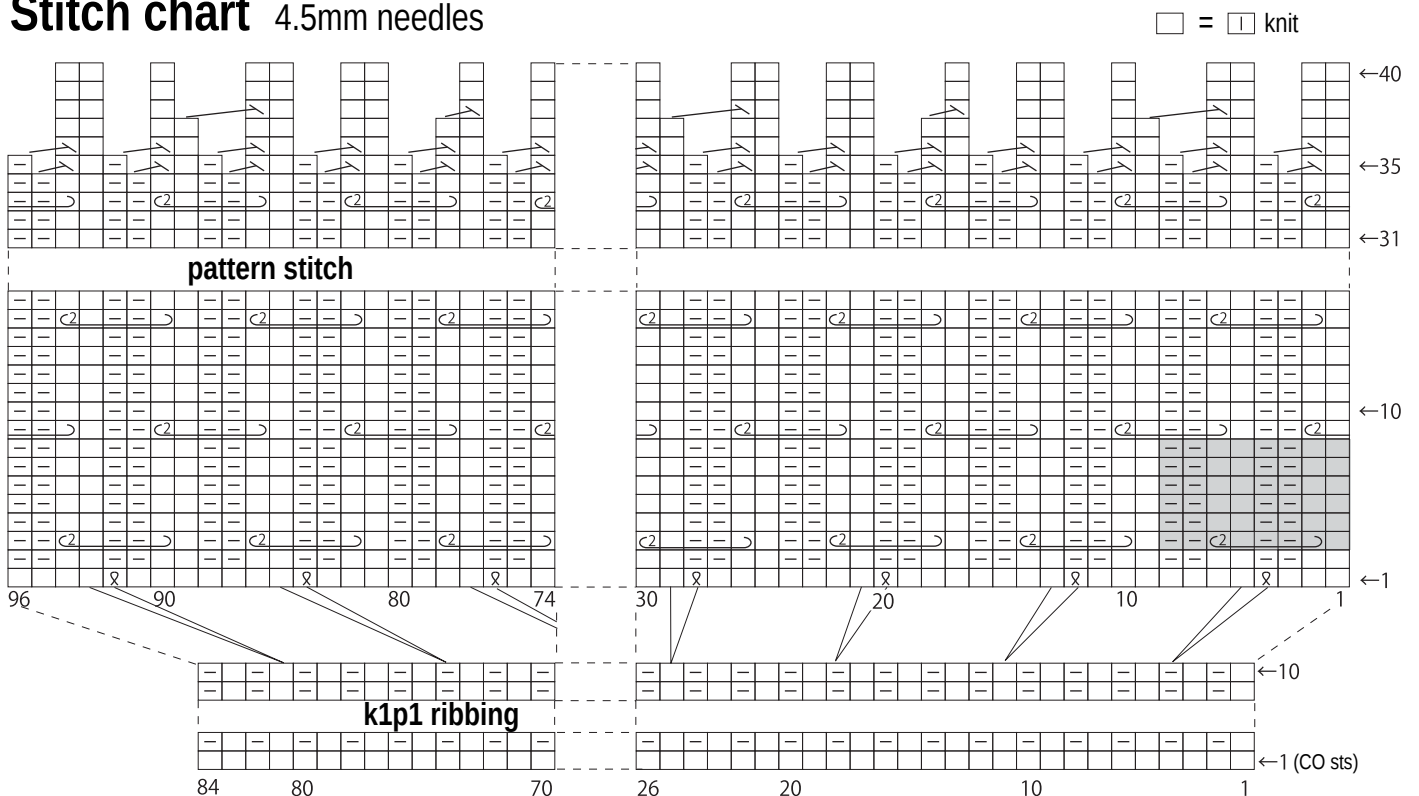
