

351lar Flower Motif Lariat



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Orgabits One [100% cotton; 142 yds/130m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #02 khaki, 1 skein [2g]
 - color #05 lavender, 1 skein [7g]
 - color #17 lemon creme, 1 skein [7g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 6 pearl beads 8mm/0.31"
- 16 glass beads 6mm/0.24"

Finished measurements:

- version A: 116cm/45.67"
- version B: 104cm/40.94"
- version C: 116cm/45.67"

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve desired size. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note 1:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

❖**Note 2:** Thread any glass beads you plan to use onto yarn before beginning to crochet.

Flower motifs: ch5, slip the center glass bead into place, and join into the round. Work in the round according to chart.

Body of lariat: For version A, work lariat, adding glass beads as you go (no leaves). For versions B and C, work lariat, working leaves as you go (no glass beads except those in flower motifs).

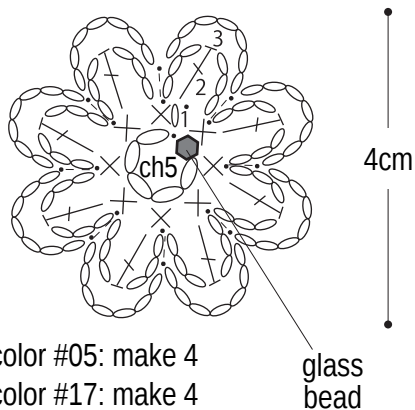
Finishing: Seam flowers to lariat as shown in finishing schematic. Fasten one pearl bead to each end of lariat.

Abbreviations:

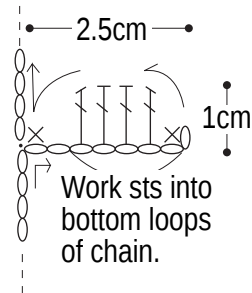
ch = chain

sc = single crochet (US)

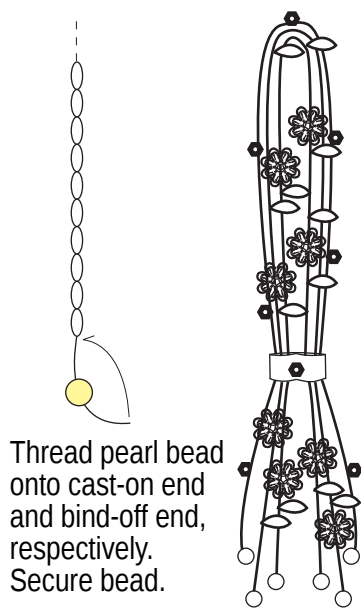
Flower motif 2.3mm hook



Leaf 2.3mm hook

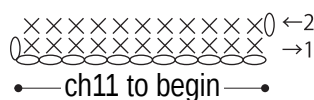

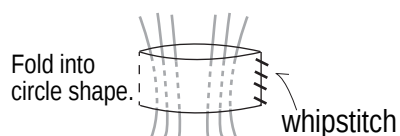
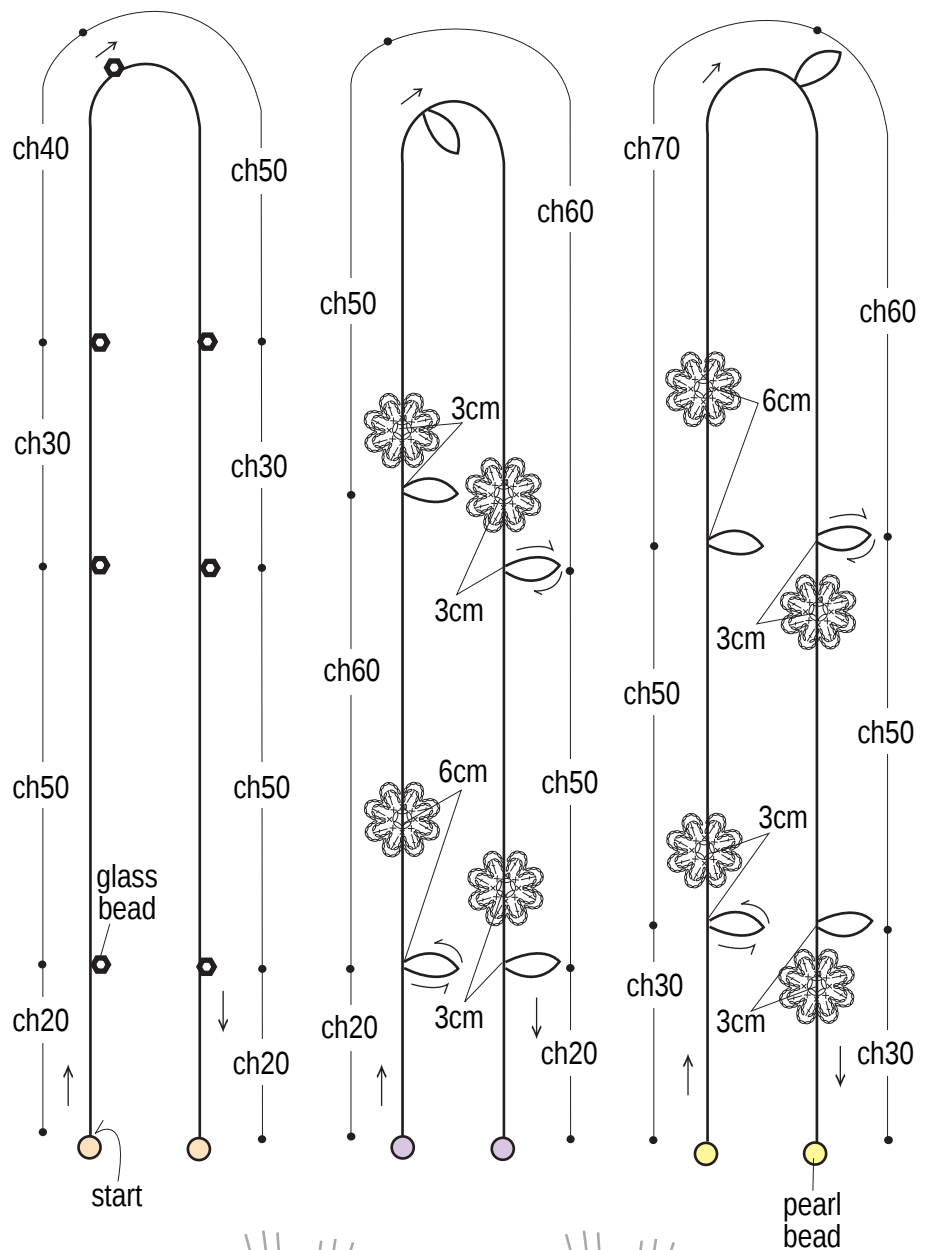


Slide 2.3mm hook

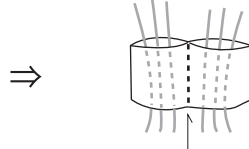

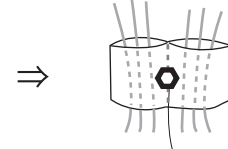
Lariat
