

387bkt Brise Tie



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Brise [69% rayon, 20% ramie, 11% polyester; 98 yds/90m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #07 navy blue, 3 skeins [40g]
 - color #08 pearl gray, 3 skeins [40g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width (at widest point) 6cm/2.36"
- length 145.5cm/57.28"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 28 sts and 20 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Necktie: With 1 strand of each color held together (2 strands total), work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch with both strands of yarn, decreasing as indicated in chart.

Finishing: Work 1 row of sc along foundation chain edge.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

RE = row(s) even

sc = single crochet (US)

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

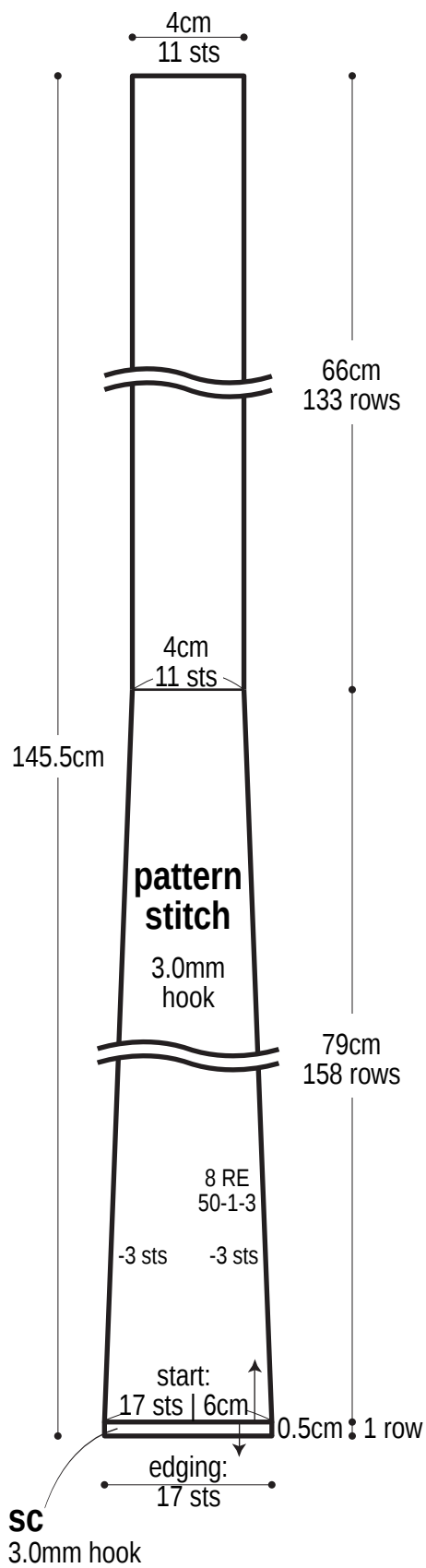


Chart 3.0mm hook
