

578sh Beauty Silk Shawl



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180 yds/165m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #12 lavender, 2 skeins [60g]
 - color #13 baby pink, 4 skeins [100g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- height 76cm/29.92"
- width 156cm/61.42"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- mesh stitches A & B: 8 chain-spaces and 10 rows
- pattern stitch: 9 pattern repeats and 10 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Shawl: ch1 to begin, then work according to chart. When body of shawl is finished, work edging A & B around outer edge of shawl. Note that edging A is worked along the two short edges, then edging B is worked along the long edge.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
ch-sp = chain-space(s)
dc = double crochet (US)
rep = pattern repeat(s)

 = color #12
 = color #13


■ = 2-st repeat

2.3mm hook


chart 4

mesh st B


