

665Mbnp Boat Neck Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S Relie [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #85 mer navy, 8 skeins [300g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.80"
- center back neck-to-cuff 28cm/11.02"
- back length 57cm/22.44"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 20 sts and 28 rows
- pattern stitch B: 24 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Lower body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch A.

Upper body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch B. To create neck opening, from row 37 to row 108 place back stitches on stitch holder. Knit the front stitches of row 108. Resume working back and front together from row 109. Refer to schematics for more details. Bind off.

Finishing: Seam pieces together according to finishing schematics.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

p = purl
