210-211-49 Ribbed Turtleneck



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% merino wool; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
color #221 black, 25 skeins [740g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) and 5.7mm (approx. US 9) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- chest 100cm/39.37"
- cross back width 40cm/15.75"
- back length 63cm/24.80"
- sleeve length 58cm/22.83"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• k2p2 ribbing: 18 sts and 22 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.


Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing. At start of armhole, bind off gusset stitches. Shape neckline by binding off stitches and by working fully fashioned decreases (worked 1 stitch in from the edge). Do not bind off shoulder stitches; place on stitch holders. Shape sleeves by working lifted increases. On row 116, place markers, then work 12 more rows. Bind off.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. Pick up stitches around neckline. Work k2p2 ribbing in the round, changing needle size when indicated to alter gauge. Bind off in pattern. Seam sleeve to body with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch, aligning gusset to sleeve from marker to edge (12 rows of sleeve). Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch.

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Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl pm = place marker PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
