

217aw-08 Soupir Raglan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soupir Wool Chuboso [53% merino wool, 31% acrylic, 15% tencel, 1% silk; 157 yds/144m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #08 Charcoal Gray, 12 skeins [455g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hooks or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 97cm/38.19"
- center back neck-to-cuff 73cm/28.74"
- back length 57cm/22.44"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- k1p1 ribbing: 28 sts and 42 rows
- pattern stitch: 28 sts and 17 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

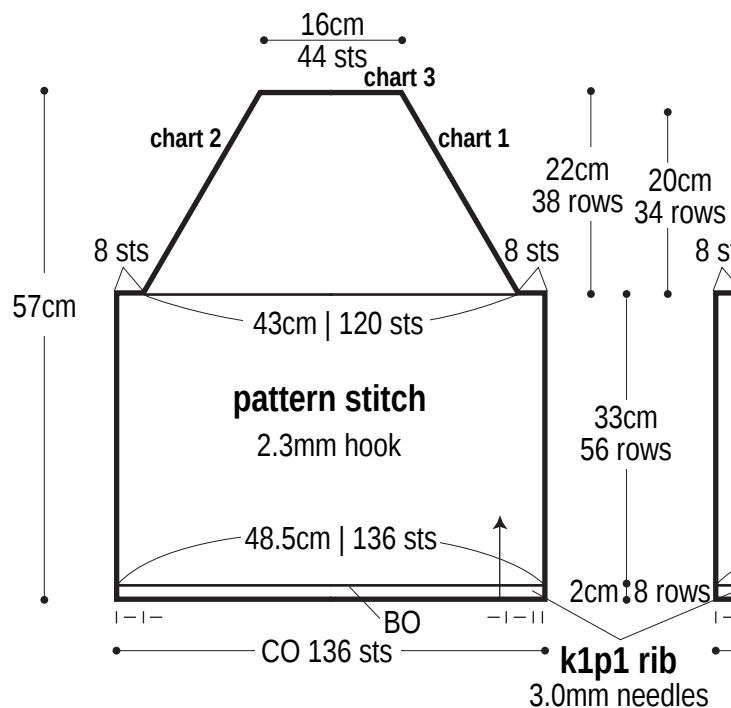
Body & sleeves: With knitting needles, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then bind off. With crochet hook, begin working pattern stitch, working first row into bound-off knitted stitches. *Reverse shaping of right sleeve for left sleeve.

Finishing: Seam raglan edges with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Seam gusset area with whipstitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with chain seam. Seam ribbing at hem and cuffs, respectively, with mattress stitch. With knitting needles, pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

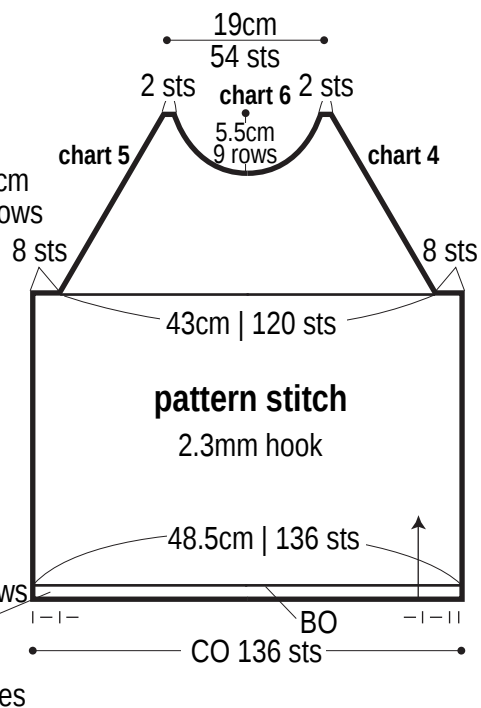

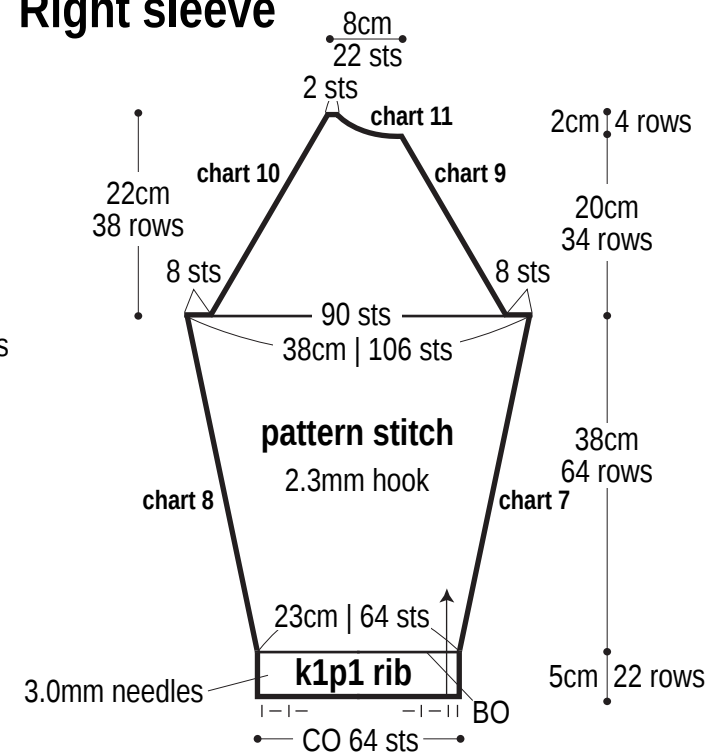


Front

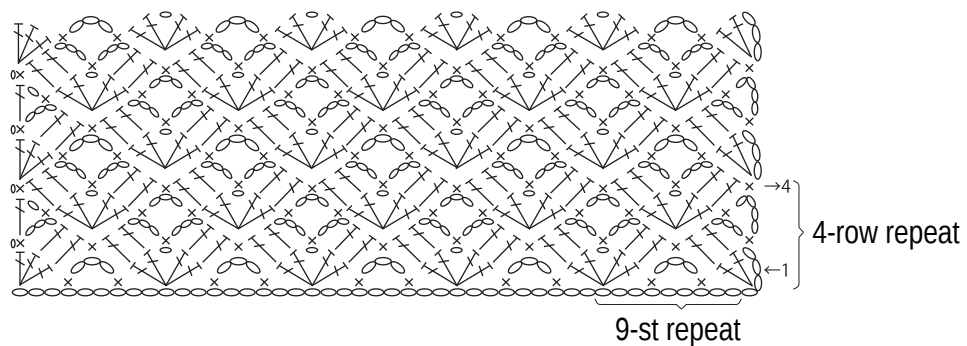


Right sleeve

※Reverse shaping for left sleeve.

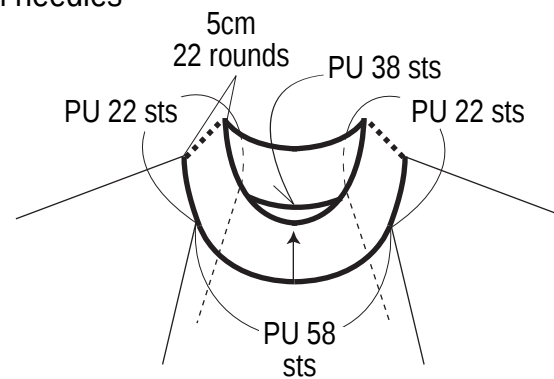


Pattern stitch 2.3mm hook

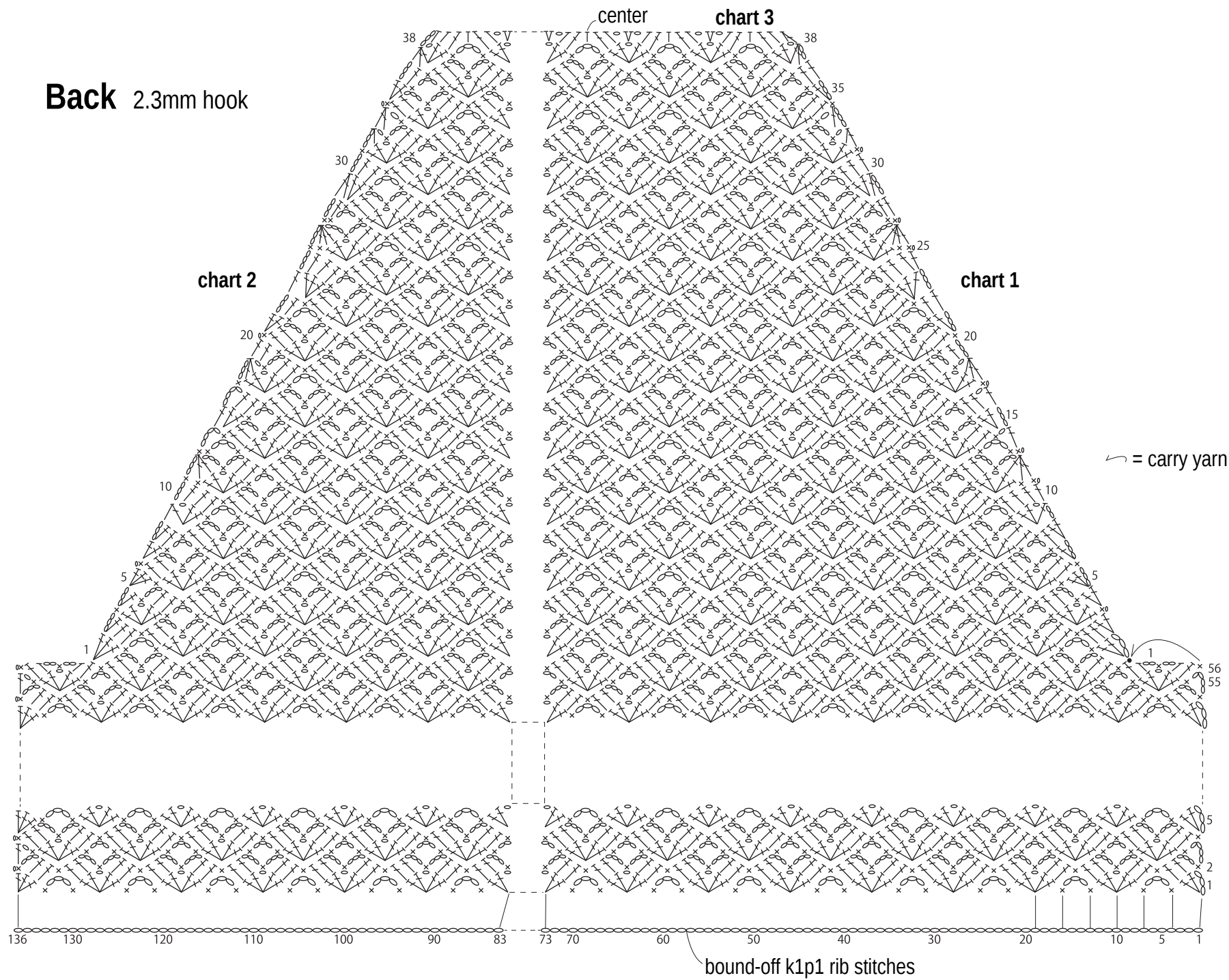


Collar: k1p1 ribbing

2.3mm hook

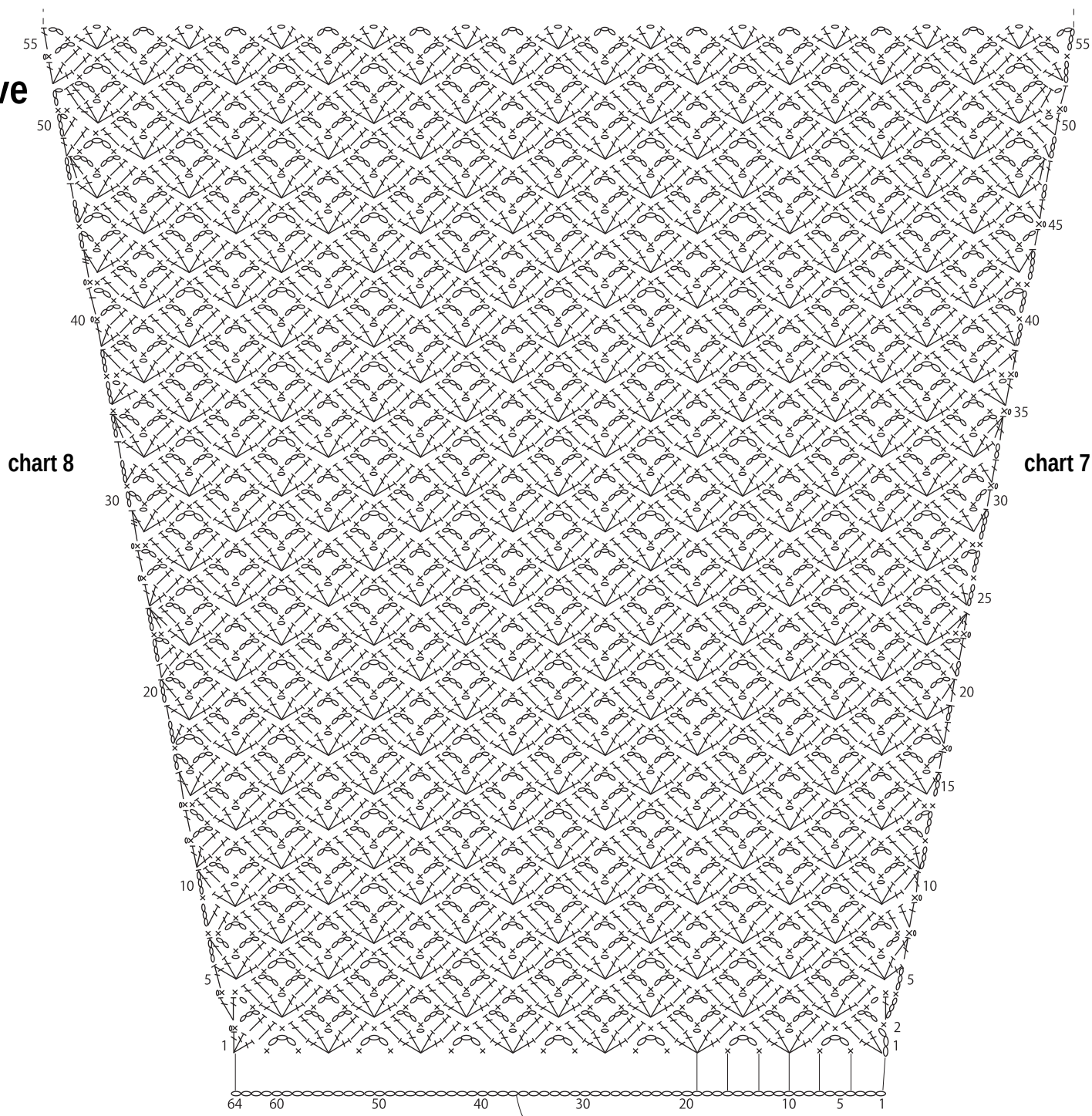
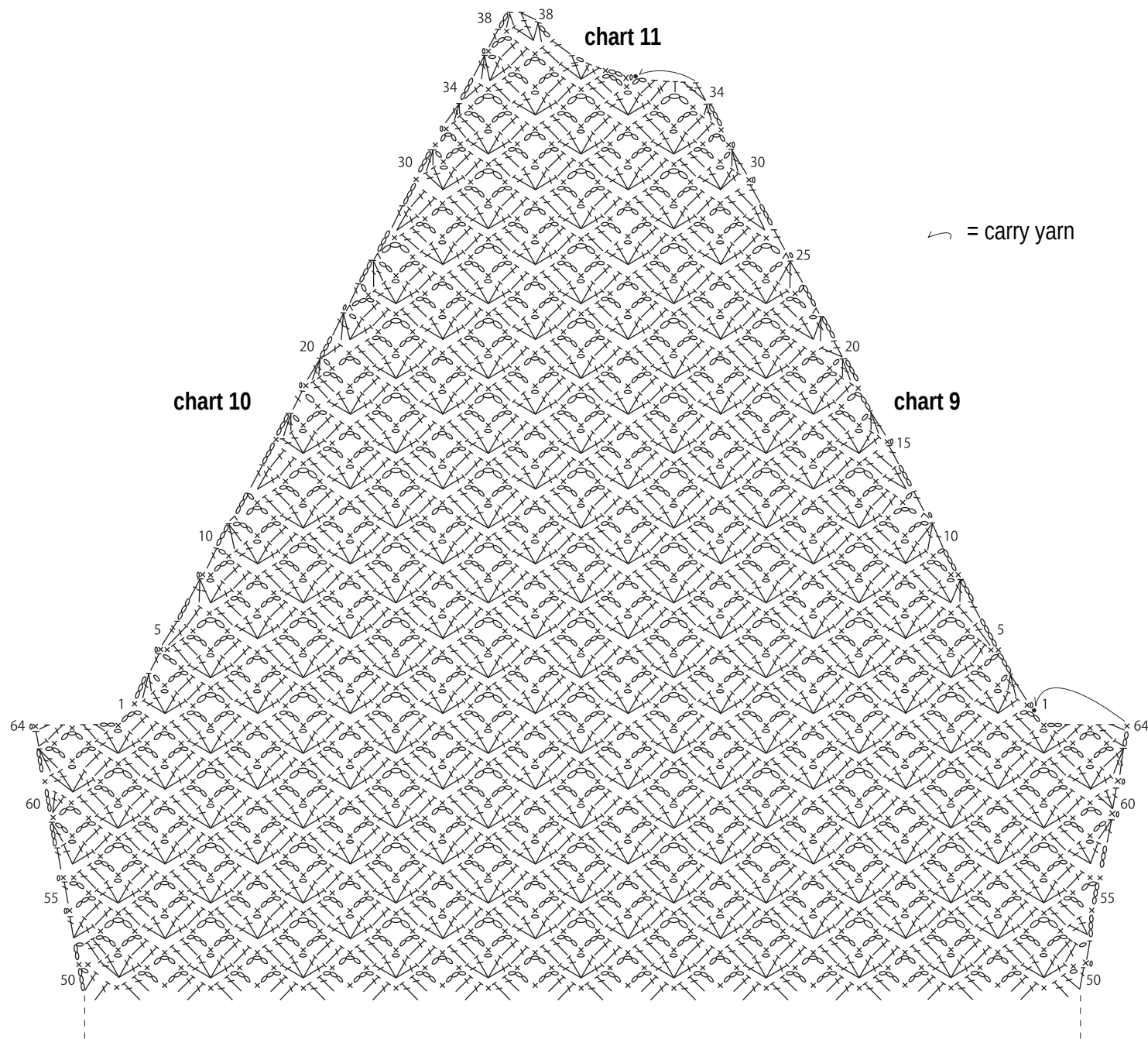
