

# 217aw-10 Lima Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Lima [50% wool, 30% nylon, 20% alpaca; 128 yds/117m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #04 mustard, 12 skeins [340g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 106cm/41.73"
- center back neck-to-cuff 72.5cm/28.54"
- back length 60cm/23.62"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (with 2 strands of yarn): 17 sts and 24 rows
- k2p2 ribbing (with 1 strand of yarn): 24 sts and 27 rows
- k1p1 ribbing (with 1 strand of yarn): 24 sts and 30 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Body:** With 1 strand of yarn, cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in stockinette stitch with 2 strands of yarn held together.

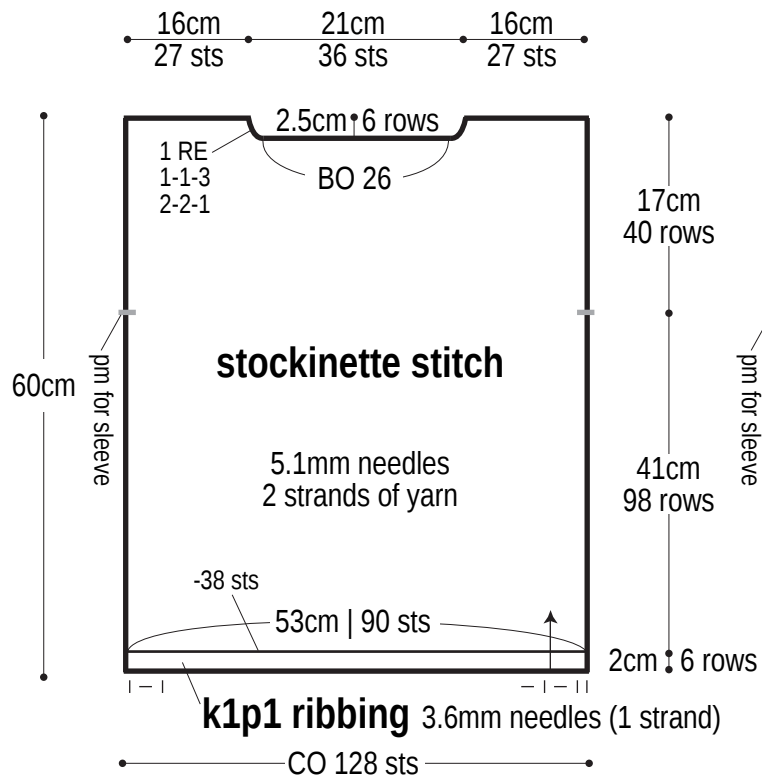
**Sleeve (make 2):** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. With 1 strand of yarn, pick up stitches and work sleeve in k2p2 ribbing towards cuff. Bind off in pattern.

**Finishing:** Seam sides and sleeves with one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side of body) using 2 strands of yarn held together. With 1 strand of yarn, pick up stitches around neckline. Work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

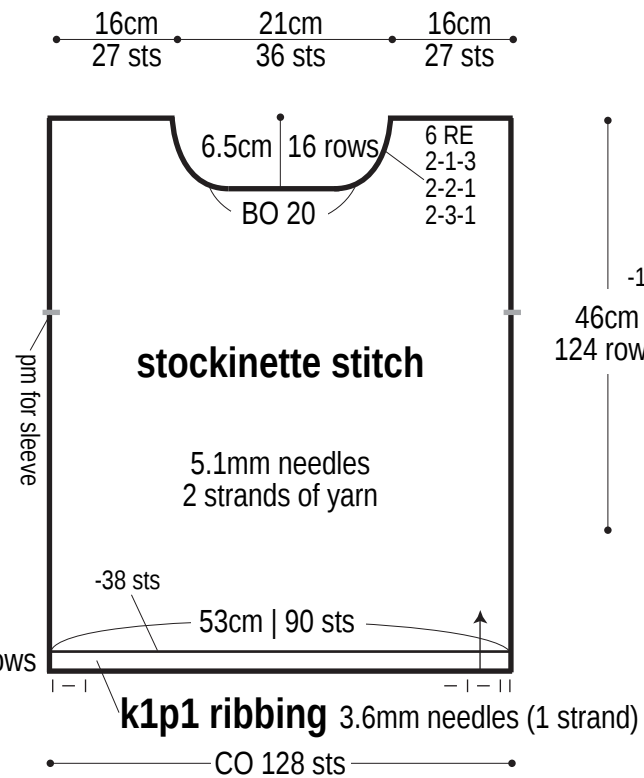
## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off      CO = cast on      k = knit      p = purl      pm = place marker      PU = pick up      RE = row(s) even      #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

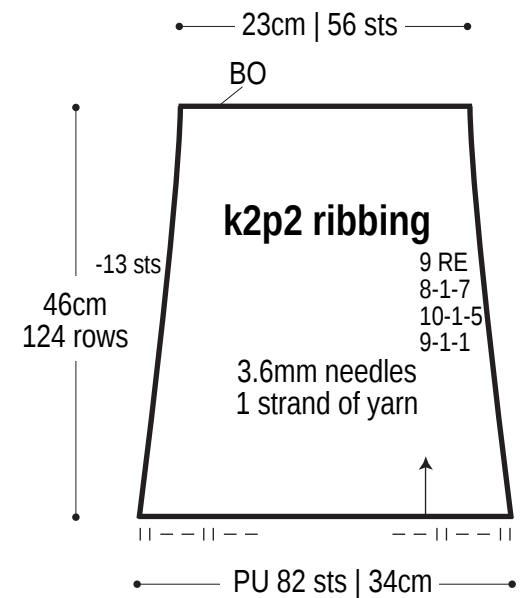
