

# 217aw-22 Needle Case



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto2/Pure Wool [100% wool; 79 yds/72m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #205 aquamarine, 4 skeins [150g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- cotton fabric for lining (110cm/43.31" x 50cm/19.69")
- darning needle
- sewing needle & thread
- leather cord (5m/16.4')

## Finished measurements:

- height 41cm/16.14"
- width 45cm/17.72"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 27 sts and 29.5 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Bind off.

**Edging:** With crochet hook, work edging around perimeter of fabric in joined rounds.

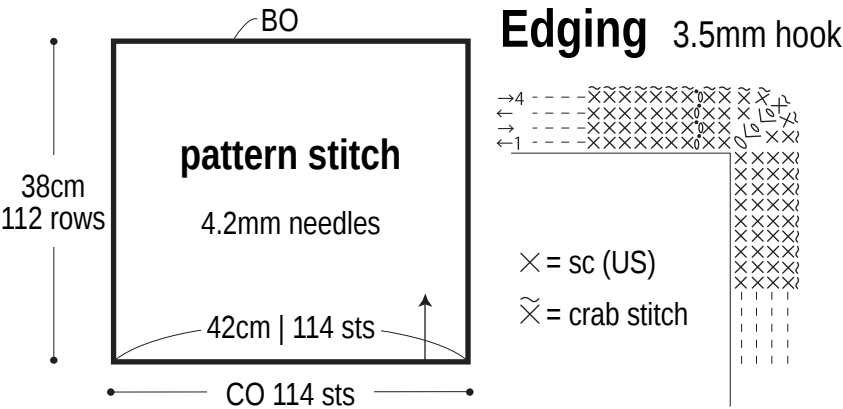
**Lining:** Cut lining fabric and sew as shown in schematic. Seam to knitted fabric.

**Finishing:** Wrap cord around edging as shown in finishing schematic. Attach remaining cord to one side of edging as shown in finishing schematic.

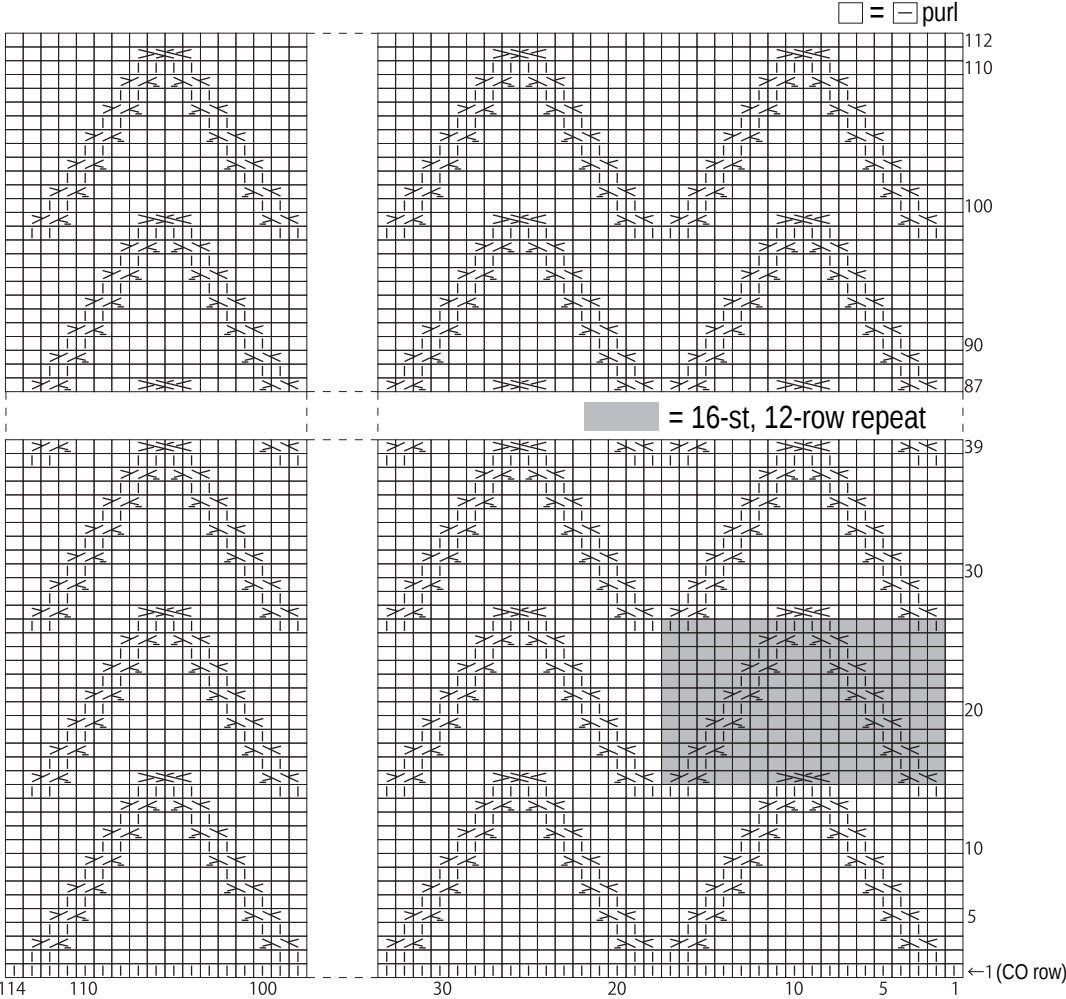
## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off      CO = cast on      RS = right side      WS = wrong side

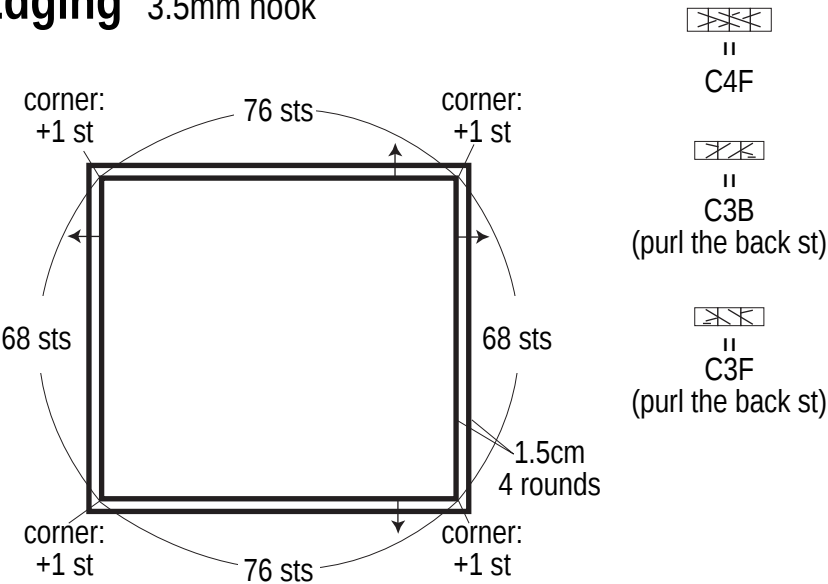
Body of case



Pattern stitch 4.2mm needles



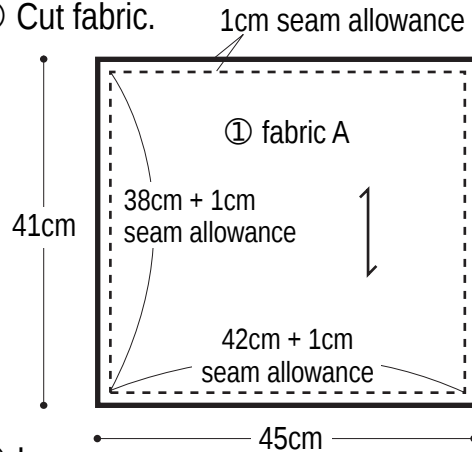
Edging 3.5mm hook



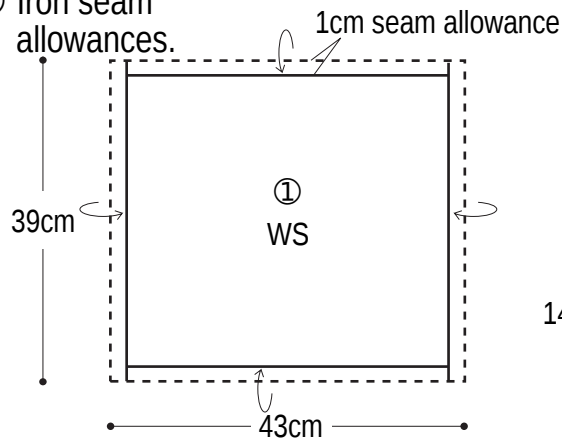
## Lining

fabric B: solid-colored cotton fabric

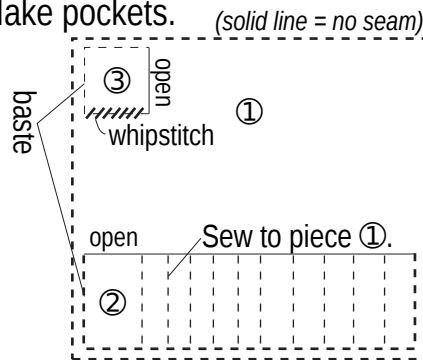
### ① Cut fabric.



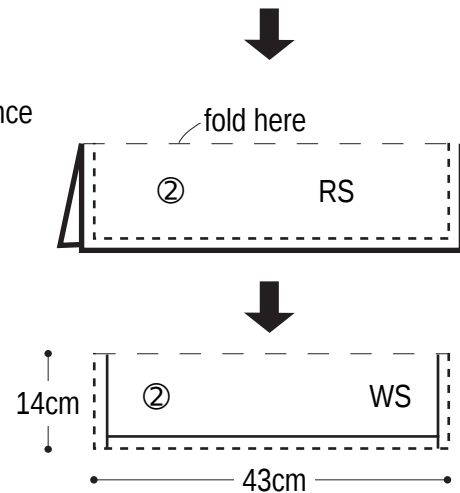
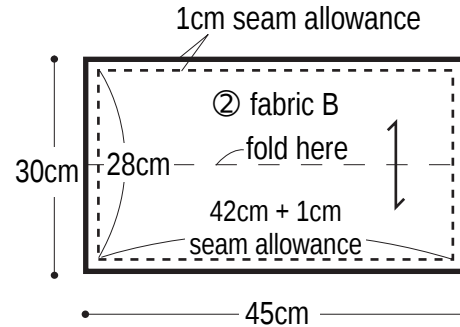
### ② Iron seam allowances.



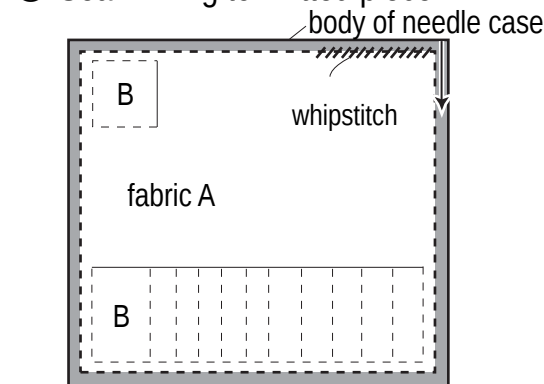
### ③ Make pockets.



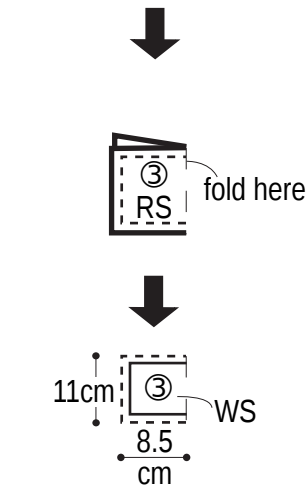
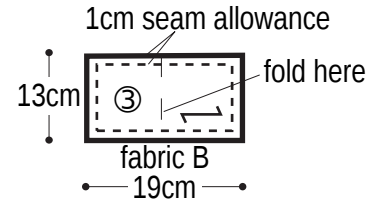
1. Place pieces ② & ③ on top of ①. Baste together.
2. Sew ② to ①, forming pockets for various needle sizes.



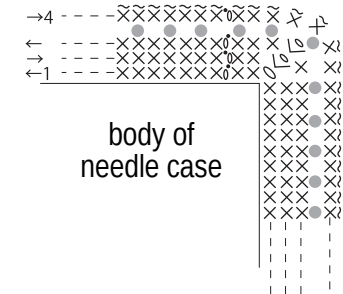
### ④ Seam lining to knitted piece.



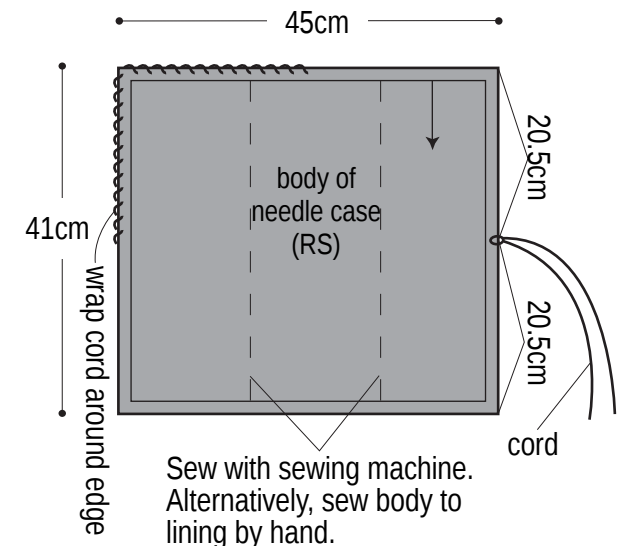
※A sewing machine may also be used.
