Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto2/Pure Wool [100% wool; 79 yds/72m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #205 aquamarine, 4 skeins [150g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- cotton fabric for lining (110cm/43.31" x 50cm/19.69")
- darning needle
- sewing needle & thread
- leather cord (5m/16.4')

Finished measurements:

- height 41cm/16.14"
- width 45cm/17.72"

Gauge (10cm/4" square): • pattern stitch: 27 sts and 29.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summarv

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Bind off.

Edging: With crochet hook, work edging around perimeter of fabric in joined rounds.

Lining: Cut lining fabric and sew as shown in schematic. Seam to knitted fabric.

Finishing: Wrap cord around edging as shown in finishing schematic. Attach remaining cord to one side of edging as shown in finishing schematic.
