

# 217aw-01 Balloon-sleeve Pullover (Mock Turtleneck)



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Urban [100% merino wool; 394 yds/360m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #07 deep green, 10 skeins [365g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4), 3.6mm (approx. US 5), and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

## Finished measurements:

- bust 98cm/38.58"
- center back neck-to-cuff 78cm/30.71"
- back length 56cm/22.05"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 24 sts and 34 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 24 sts and 26.5 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

✿**Note:** entire garment worked with 3 strands of yarn held together.

**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and then continue in stockinette stitch. Place markers for sleeves where indicated.

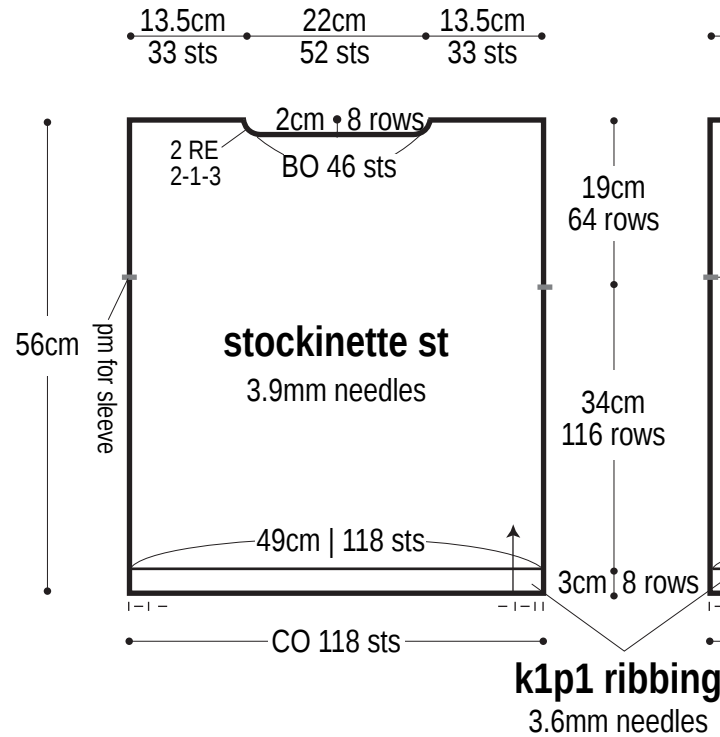
**Sleeve:** Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch, then bind off. Remove provisional cast-on edge; pick up live stitches and work in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work k1p1 ribbing in the round (see schematic). Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch seam.

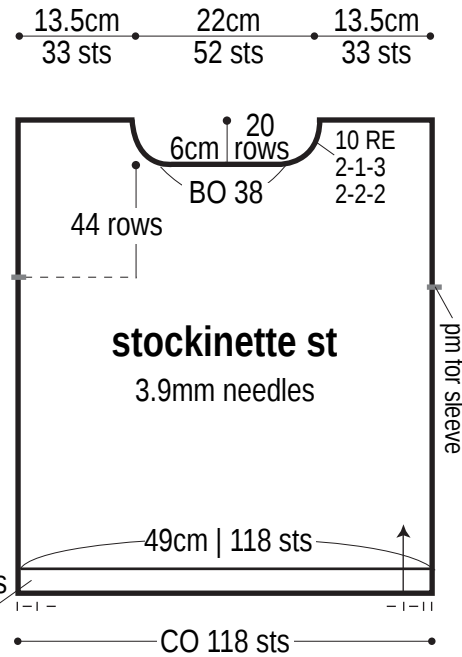
## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off      CO = cast on      k = knit      p = purl      pm = place marker      PU = pick up      RE = row(s) even      st st = stockinette stitch      #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

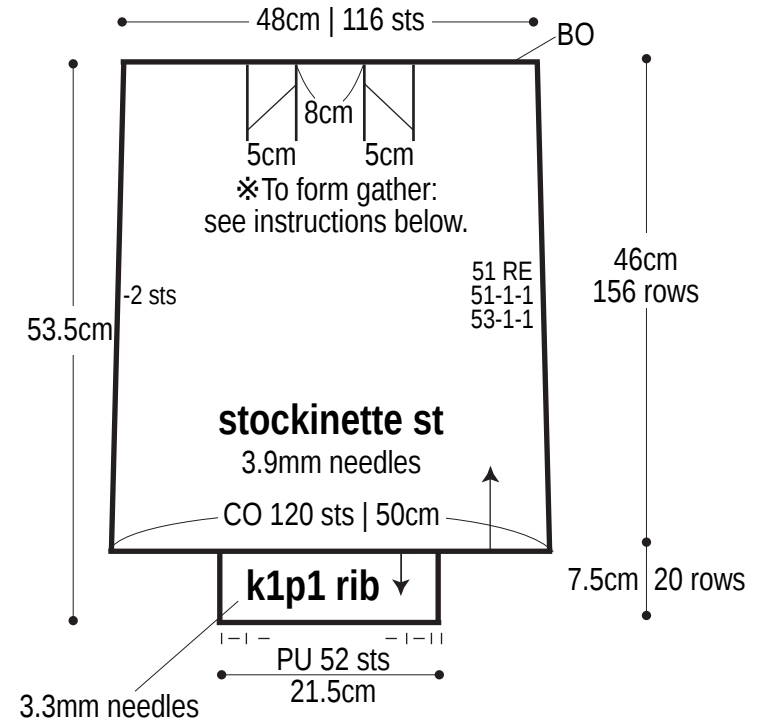

## Front

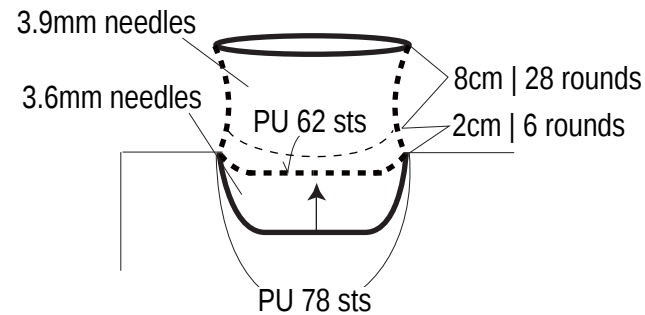


## Sleeve
