

217aw-13 Nordic Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Rover [100% wool; 61 yds/56m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #04 Melange Brown, 1 skein [15g]
 - color #15 Earth Blue, 1 skein [15g]
 - color #16 Red Bean, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #18 Blue Gray, 6 skeins [225g]
 - color #20 Ecru Beige, 7 skeins [265g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.4mm (approx. US 9) and 6.0mm (US 10) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- center back neck-to-cuff 72cm/28.35"
- back length 62cm/24.41"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch & stranded pattern stitch: 15 sts and 17 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 16 sts and 23 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.



Summary

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work k1p1 ribbing, then continue in stranded pattern stitch. To avoid puckering of fabric, take care not to pull the yarn carried across the back of the work tightly. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases (worked 2 stitches in from the edge).


Finishing: Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam underarm gusset with Kitchener stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times




Right sleeve

Collar


k1p1 ribbing
