210-211-16-1 Earflap Hat



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Antique Slub [50% wool, 50% acrylic; 27 yds/25m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
color #5 pink/orange variegated, 5 skeins [130g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.6mm (approx. US 101/2) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 50cm/19.7"
- length 18cm/7.1"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• stockinette stitch: 10 sts and 15 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body of hat: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 20 rows, then begin working evenly spaced decreases as shown. After working last row, cut yarn and thread tail through all remaining stitches and cinch top of hat shut.


Earflap (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 12 rows, increasing as indicated. Bind off.


Finishing: Seam sides with mattress stitch. Seam earflaps to hat where indicated using whipstitch. Crochet sc edging along rim of hat and edges of earflaps. Make two 3-strand braids and attach one to each earflap. Make pompom and fasten to top of hat.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on sc = single crochet (US) st st = stockinette stitch #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
