217aw-02 Hensel Square Vest



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Hensel [80% mohair, 20% silk; 120 yds/110m per 0.71 oz./20g skein]; color #23 Royal Blue, 11 skeins [215g]

Tools/Notions:

• 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

• bust 104cm/40.94"

center back neck-to-cuff 28cm/11.02"

back length 52.5cm/20.67"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

pattern stitch: 21 sts and 15 rows
double crochet (US): 17 sts and 9 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note 1: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

*Note 2: Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.


Body (make 2): ch3 with separate piece of yarn and set aside for later. With main yarn, work foundation chain (109 sts). Work in pattern stitch until underarm. For right underarm, increase by working 3 additional stitches. For left underarm, work 3 stitches into the chain you prepared earlier. Continue working in pattern stitch. After making second body piece, seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern).

Neckline: Crochet neckline edging around neckline in the round according to chart.

Finishing: Seam sides and sleeve undersides with chain seam. Work sc edging around cuffs and hem in the round.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain sc = single crochet (US)
