## 217aw-14 Ladies' Coatigan



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Rabbits [43% mohair, 41% acrylic, 16% nylon; 63 yds/58m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #04 Ann, 19 skeins [740g]
- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Fingering [100% merino wool; 183 yds/167m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #08 Dust Brown, 7 skeins [260g]

### Tools/Notions:

- 7.0mm (no close US equivalent) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle
- 1 button (28mm/1.10")

### **Finished measurements:**

- bust 108cm/42.52"
- cross back width 51cm/20.08"
- back length 98cm/38.58"
- sleeve length 39cm/15.35"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch & reverse stockinette stitch & pattern stitch: 12 sts and 15 rows
- garter stitch: 12 sts and 20 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

### **Summary**

**Back:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in garter stitch, then pattern stitch and reverse stockinette stitch (see schematic). Bind off. Pick up stitches along bind-off edge and work in pattern stitch. Form tucks in sections marked with ★, layering the fabric three times. Then pick up stitches from the tucked section (making sure to pick up through all 3 layers).

Front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in garter stitch, then continue in pattern stitch. Reverse shaping of right front for left front.


Sleeve (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st. Bind off.


Pocket (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st. Bind off.


**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam, but graft gusset with Kitchener stitch. Seam sides and sleeves with mattress stitch (one seam per side of body/sleeve). Fold up each cuff and seam with whipstitch in place. Seam pockets to front as shown in finishing schematic. Work 1 row of sc edging along front edges and neckline.



BO = bind off CO = cast on RE = row(s) even sc = single crochet (US) st st = stockinette stitch #-#-# = rows-stitches-times









# **How to form gathers**
