217w-04 Simple Turtleneck Vest



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% merino wool; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz/30g skein]; color #221 Black, 10 skeins [300g]

Tools/Notions:

• 3.6mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- · cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- back length 58cm/22.83"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• k1p2 ribbing: 28 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body (front & back): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p2 ribbing. Shape armscye with fully fashioned decreases worked 5 stitches in from the edge (see armscye chart).

Pocket (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p2 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides from top of slip (marked with stitch marker) to underarm using mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p2 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Sew pockets to front where indicated in finishing schematic using whipstitch.


