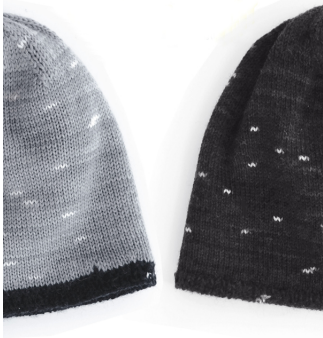


18rc Reversible Cap



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso Gradation [50% wool, 50% merino wool; 164 yds/150m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #1701 Gray, 1 skein [35g]
 - color #1705 Black, 1 skein [40g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- hat opening circumference 54cm/21.26"
- head depth 22cm/8.66"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 26 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

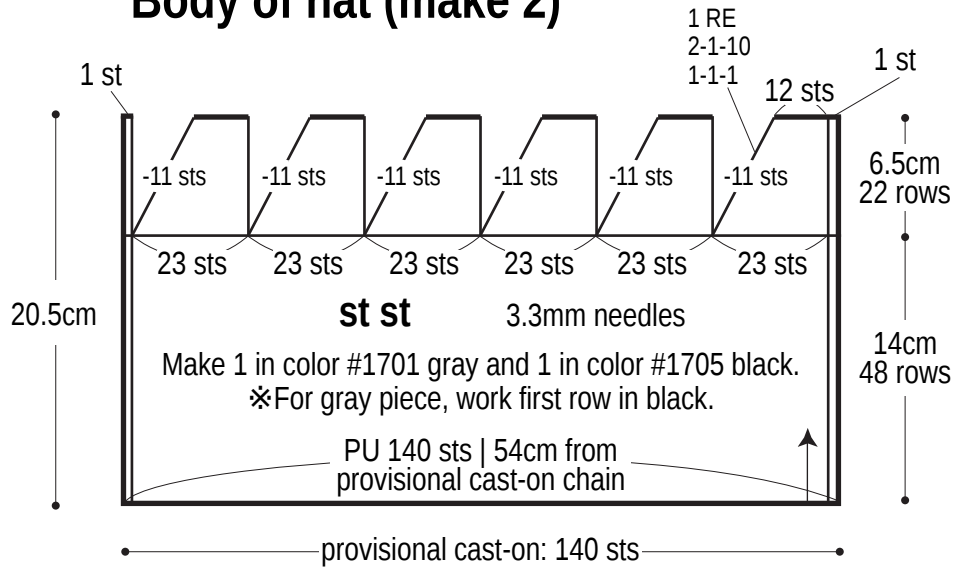
Body: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method (or another provisional cast-on method of your choice). With color 1705 (black), work first row in st st. Change to color 1701 (gray) and continue working in st st. Make second hat piece the same as the first but work it entirely in color 1705.

Finishing: Remove provisional cast-on edge from each hat piece and pick up live stitches. With WRONG sides facing each other, join the pieces together by working k1p1 ribbing, alternating picking up 1 st from first piece and 1 st from second piece on the first row of ribbing. When ribbing is complete, bind off in pattern. Thread yarn through sts of last row of gray and black pieces; cinch the tops of the pieces together with each color. Sew the side seam for each piece (gray and black) with the matching yarn with right side out using mattress stitch. Seam the ribbing with black side facing you using mattress stitch. Fasten the tops of the two pieces together on the inside.

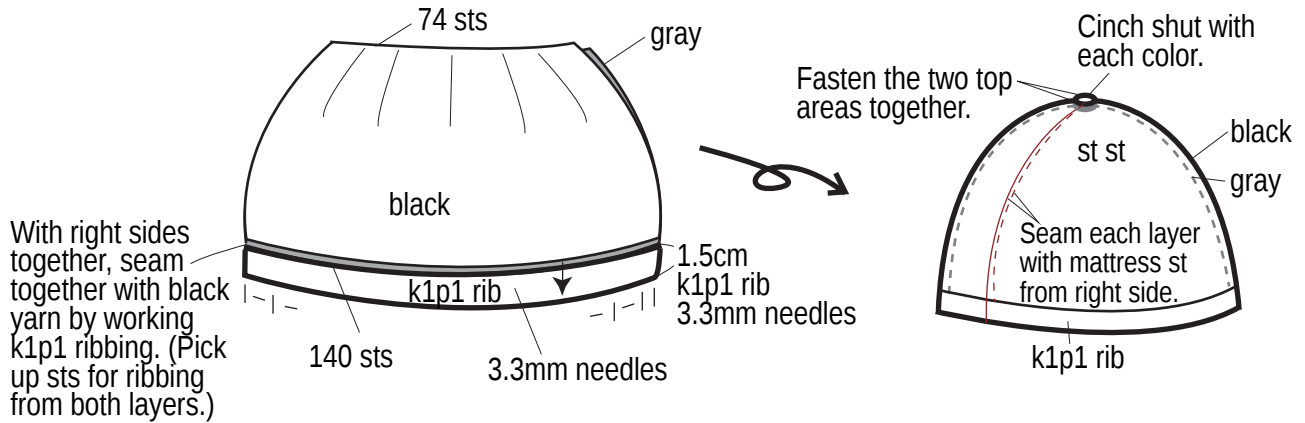
Abbreviations:

CO = cast on
k = knit
p = purl
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
st st = stockinette stitch
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
