

# 217aw-11 Rollo Hat



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Rollo [90% merino wool, 10% nylon; 27 yds/25m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #03 Painter, 3 skeins [105g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10.5) and 8.0mm (US 11) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

## Finished measurements:

- circumference 52cm/20.47"
- head depth 24.5cm/9.65"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 11 sts and 16 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 9 sts and 13 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Hat:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then in pattern stitch. Starting on round 25, begin working decreases as shown in chart. On last row, cut yarn and thread tail through remaining 44 stitches.

**Finishing:** Seam side of hat with mattress stitch from bottom to top. When finished seaming, thread yarn tail through stitches at top and cinch top of hat shut.

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

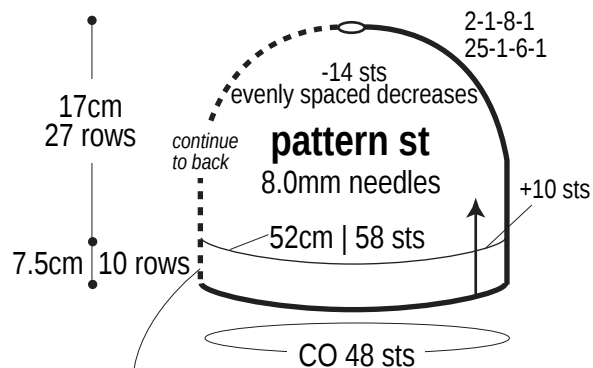
CO = cast on

k = knit

p = purl

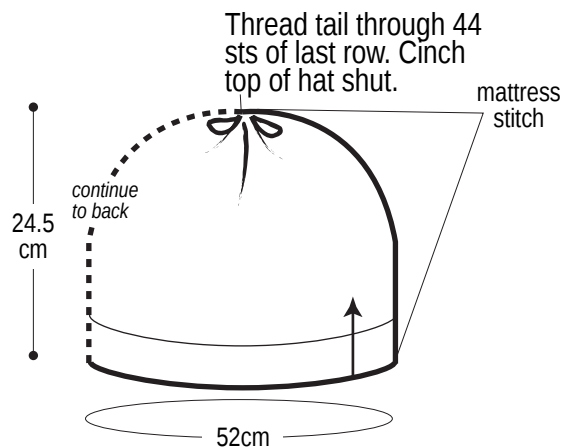
#-#-# = rounds-stitches-places-times [for evenly spaced decreases across entire width of an item]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 row, decrease 2 stitches in each of 3 places across the round; do this 4 times total."
