

# tricot12-2 Grandir Cardigan



## Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Grandir [80% wool, 20% alpaca; 79 yds/72m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #11 Snow, 21 skeins [815g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US 10) and 6.6mm (approx. US 10.5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 98cm/38.58"
- center back neck-to-cuff 72.5cm/28.54"
- back length 58cm/22.83"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- garter stitch: 13 sts and 20 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 15 sts and 20 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

❖**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

**Body (back, right front & left front):** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and then in garter stitch. Reverse shaping of right front for left front.

**Sleeve (make 2):** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and then in garter stitch. Bind off.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. For front, crochet 2 chains (one ch17 and one ch16). For right front and left front, pick up and knit into chain and then continue down front edge. Work collar and buttonband in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off. Referring to finishing schematic, seam back of collar with mattress stitch. Seam long edge of collar to body with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch.

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off  
ch = chain stitch  
CO = cast on  
k = knit  
p = purl  
pm = place marker  
PU = pick up  
RE = row(s) even  
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
