

218s-04 Long Tilden Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pochette [50% merino wool, 50% cotton; 131 yds/120m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #01 Pure White, 1 skein [25g]
 - color #08 Indico Blue, 7 skeins [270g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 31cm/12.20"
- back length 75cm/29.53"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 20 sts and 31.5 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 25 sts and 35 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Reverse shaping of right front for left front. After working pattern stitch section, pick up stitches from cast-on edge and work k1p1 ribbing. Bind off.

Buttonband and collar: Before you begin knitting the buttonband and collar, crochet two chains for the collar (see schematic) and set aside until you need them. With knitting needles, pick up stitches along front edges and from each of the two crochet chains made in advance for the collar. Work buttonband in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off.

Pocket (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch and k1p1 ribbing. Bind off.

Sleeve (make 2): Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches from body (between markers and shoulder); work sleeve from top down in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off.

Finishing: Referring to finishing schematic, seam center back of collar with mattress stitch, then seam back collar to back neckline. Seam sides and sleeves with one continuous mattress stitch seam per side of body/sleeve. Whipstitch pockets to body of garment where indicated in finishing schematic.

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl pm = place marker PU = pick up

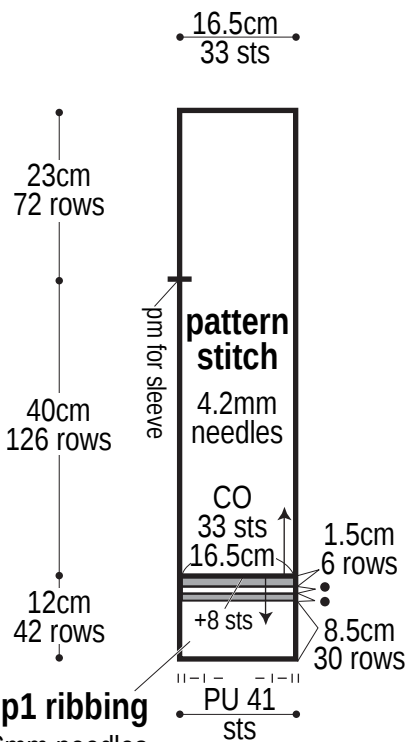

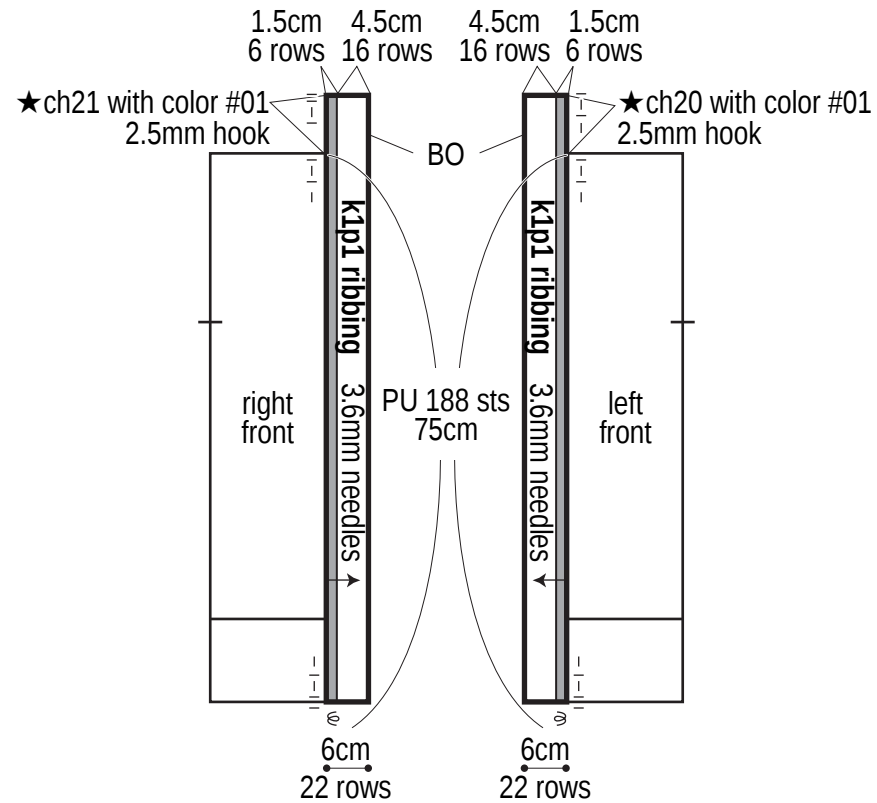
