

1207tb Little Fun Turban



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Little Fun [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
- color #52 Sprout, 2 skeins [35g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- circumference 50cm/19.69"
- width 8cm/3.15"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 32 sts and 29 rows
- pattern stitch B: 24 sts and 8.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body of headband: With knitting needles, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch A.

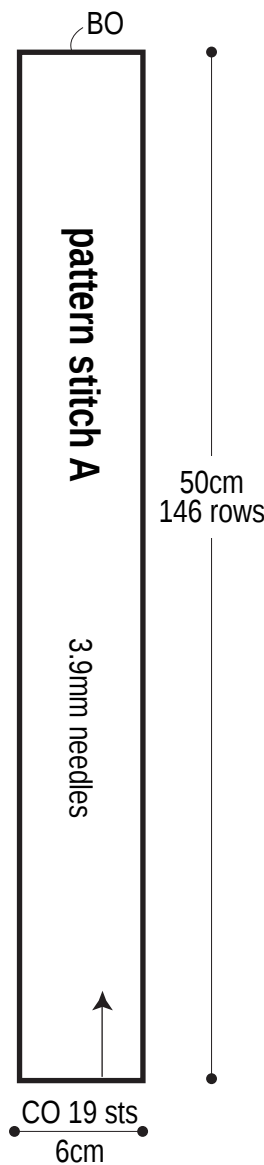
Parts A & B: With crochet hook, work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch B.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other, seam cast-on edge of headband to its bind-off edge with whipstitch. Crochet edging in the round. Form gathers at center of part A. Place part A over seam at back of headband. Wrap part B around center of part A and headband. Secure in place with whipstitch work on wrong side of headband.

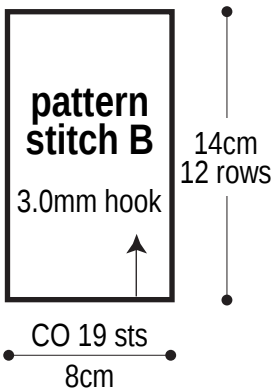
Abbreviations:

RS = right side

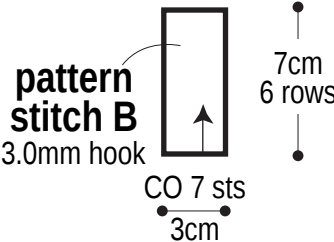
Body of headband



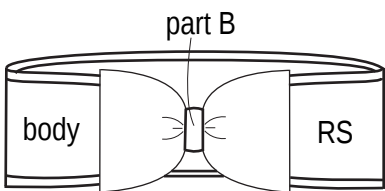
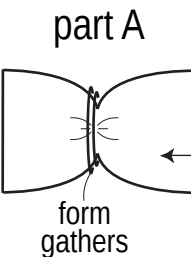
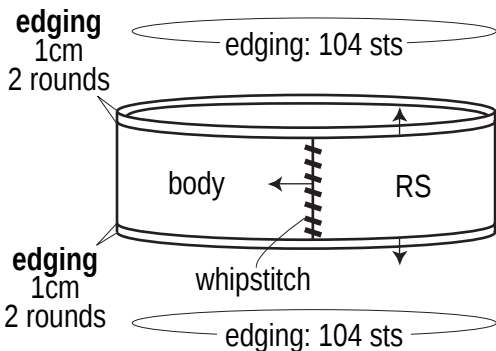

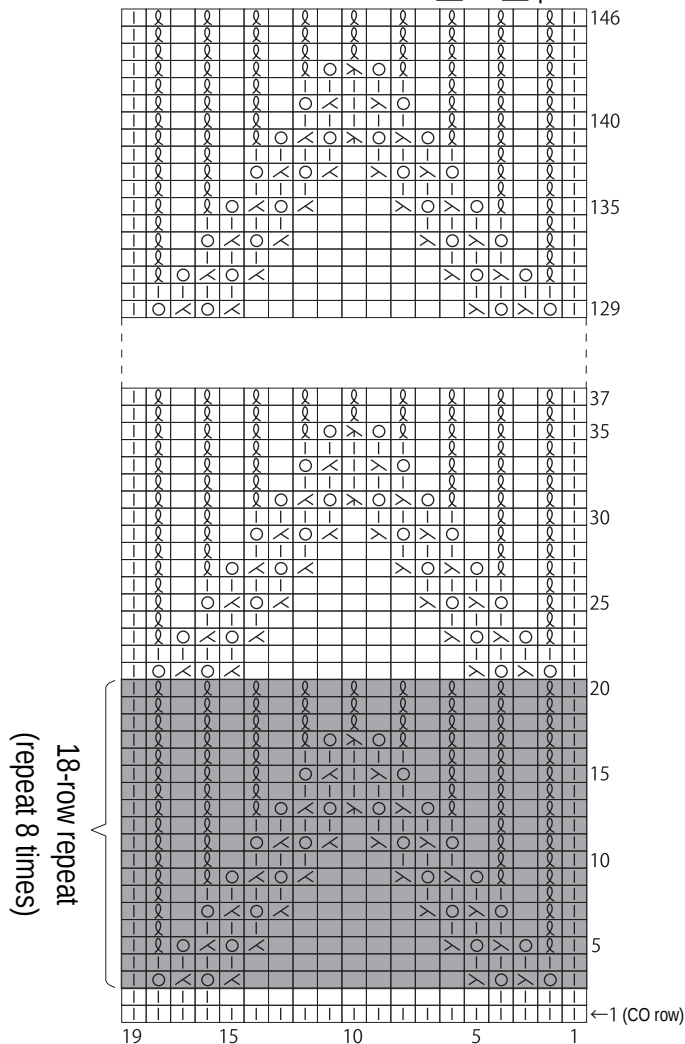

Body of headband: pattern stitch A

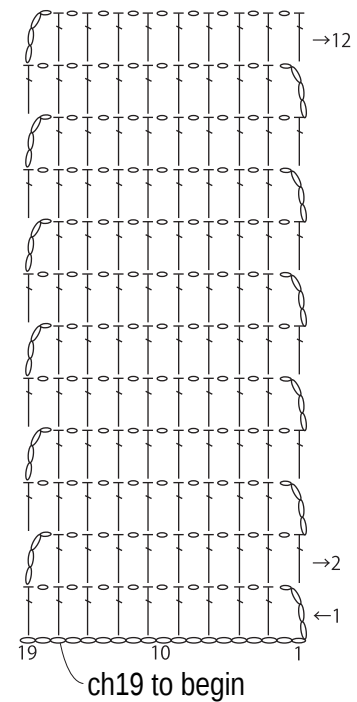
3.9mm needles

□ = — purl



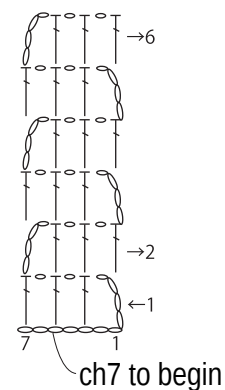
Part A: pattern stitch B
