

22-23-7 Chenille Tee



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pocchi Moll [100% nylon; 55 yds/50m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #1 White, 5 skeins [175g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.7mm (approx. US 9) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 84cm/33.07"
- cross back width 34cm/13.39"
- back length 51cm/20.08"
- sleeve length 17cm/6.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 11 sts and 18 rows
- pattern stitch: 11 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st. Seam sides by working fully fashioned lifted increases (worked 1 st in from the edge) according to schematic. Shape armscye by binding off stitches as indicated and by working decreases at edges (see schematic). Work yoke section in pattern stitch. Note that bobbles in pattern stitch are crocheted by working ch6. Shape shoulders with short rows, then bind off stitches at center for boat neck collar. Do not bind shoulders stitches off; place on stitch holder for seaming later.

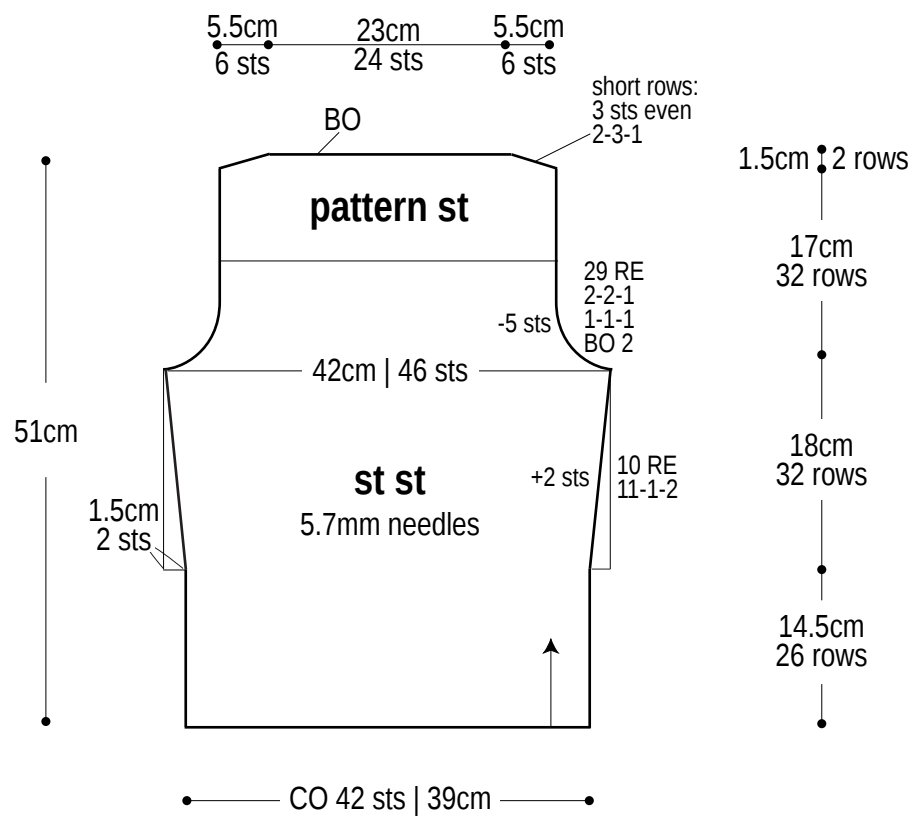
Sleeve (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work first 10 rows in pattern stitch, then work the rest of the sleeve in st st.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

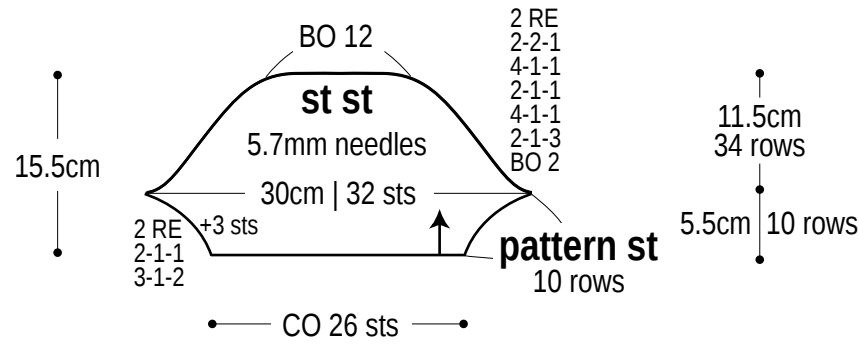
BO = bind off
ch = chain stitch
CO = cast on
RE = row(s) even
st st = stockinette stitch
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
