218s-12 Ribbed Summer Cap



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Orgabits One [100% organic cotton; 142 yds/130m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
color #12 honey gold, 2 skeins [50g]

Tools/Notions:

• 3.3mm (approx. US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

• Please see finishing schematic.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- k1p1 ribbing: 29.5 sts and 35 rows
- k2p2 ribbing: 29.5 sts and 37 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Hat: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then continue in k1p1 ribbing according to schematic. On last 10 rows, work decreases according to chart.

Finishing: On last row, cut yarn and thread through all live stitches, cinching top of hat shut. Weave in ends to secure top of hat shut. Seam sides with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on


k = knit


p = purl

RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-places-times [for evenly spaced decreases across entire span of item]. For example,1-2-3-4 means "every 1 row, decrease 2 stitches in each of 3 places across the row; do this 4 timestotal."
