

# 218ss-09 Relie Tee



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S Relie [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #81 charrette gray, 10 skeins [400g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- chest 106cm/41.73"
- center back neck-to-cuff 48.5cm/19.09"
- back length 62cm/24.41"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch & reverse stockinette stitch: 21 sts and 29 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Body & sleeves:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. For each piece (front, back, each sleeve), work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in reverse st st. Do not bind off shoulder stitches; place live stitches on stitch holders. Bind off sleeves.

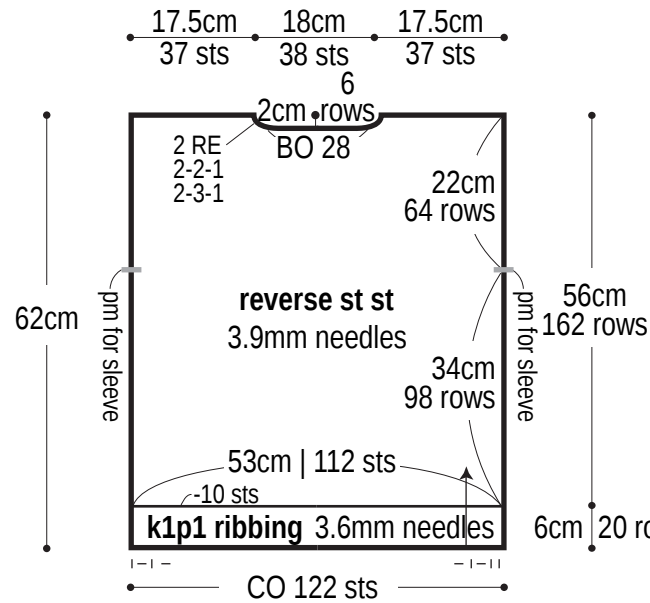
**Pocket:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st and then in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. In order to have the seam stitches show from the right side, seam sleeves from wrong side using stitches-to-rows mattress stitch (see finishing schematic). Then seam sleeve undersides and side of garment in one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side of body) from the wrong side. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Seam pocket to front using mattress stitch and whipstitch (see finishing schematic).

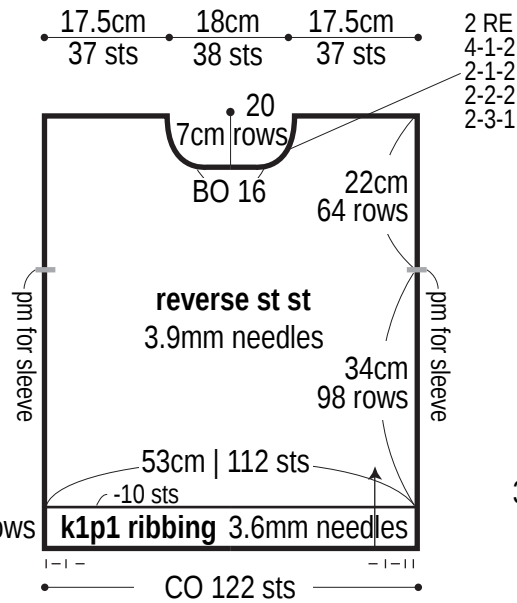

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

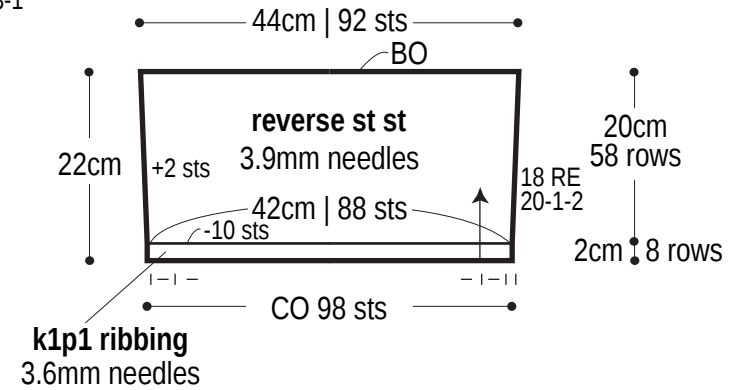

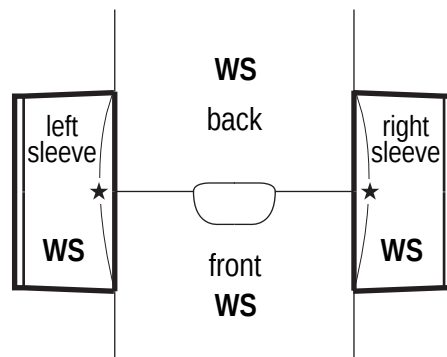
## Front



## Sleeve (make 2)

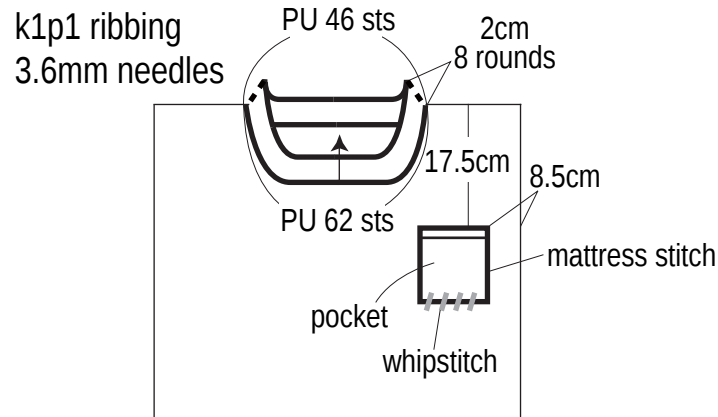
