# 1215ve Back Slit Vest



#### Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Dandy Alice [100% merino wool; 151 yds/138m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
color #10 biscotti, 3 skeins [200g]

## **Tools/Notions:**

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 buttons (21mm/0.83")

# Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- back length 60cm/23.62"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitches A & B: 26 sts and 35 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### Summary

**Back & front body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and then in pattern stitch A. With crochet hook, work a column of slip stitch up each side of the body (see schematic).

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Front yoke: Pick up stitches from front body, then work in garter stitch and pattern stitch B.

**Back yoke:** Pick up stitches from back body (allowing 5 stitches at center back to overlap as shown in schematic), then work in garter stitch and pattern stitch B.


**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline and cuffs, respectively; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Attach buttons to tab at center back of garment.

#### Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain stitch CO = cast on k = knit OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder) p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even rep = pattern repeat(s) sc = single crochet (US) #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
