

1224lg Long Gilet



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fantastic Magie [45% wool, 30% nylon, 25% silk; 77 yds/70m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #10 charcoal, 26 skeins [775g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 wooden buttons (45mm/1.77")

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.80"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- back length 98cm/38.58"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- reverse stockinette stitch: 14 sts and 21 rows
- pattern stitches A & B: 14 sts and 21 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch A and then in reverse st st. When you reach the armhole shaping, work armhole edges in pattern stitch B.

Front: Begin as for back. Work buttonband in pattern stitch A, but take care to work buttonholes only in right front. Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch.


Hood: Pick up stitches around neckline; work hood in pattern stitch A and reverse st st. Seam top of hood with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:


- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)
- PU = pick up
- RE = row(s) even
- st st = stockinette stitch
- #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

*Note: entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.



Right front




Hood 5.1mm needles

$\blacksquare = 4\text{-st, 4-row repeat}$


start left front

$\square = \blacksquare$ purl




$\blacksquare = 4\text{-st, 2-row repeat}$

5.1mm needles


$\square = \blacksquare$ purl
