

1246cd Muret Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Muret [100% baby alpaca; 792 yds/724m per 7.05 oz./200g cone]; color: natural undyed (dark brown), 2 cones [400g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 37cm/14.57"
- back length 50.5cm/19.88"
- sleeve length 44.5cm/17.52"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 27.5 sts and 13 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body & sleeves: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch according to charts & schematics.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sleeves to body with chain seam. Seam underarm gusset with whipstitch. On each side of the body, seam from sleeve cuff to side hem with one continuous chain seam. Work edging in the round along each cuff. Work edging in the round along hem, front edges, and neckline.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
dc = double crochet (US)
fp = front post
sc = single crochet (US)
tr = treble crochet (US)

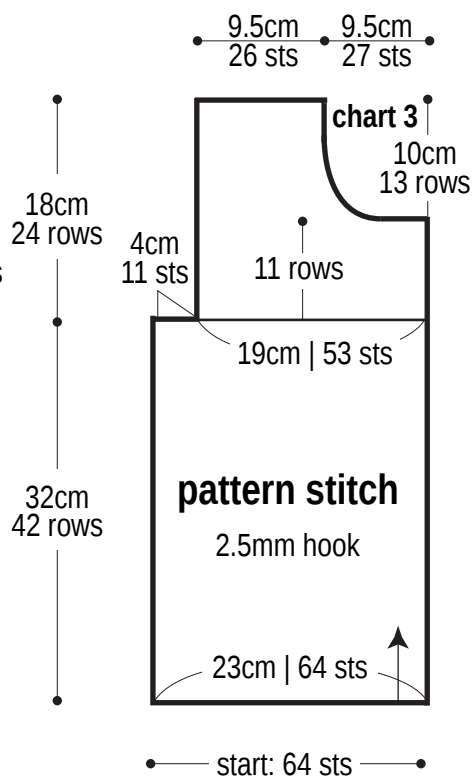
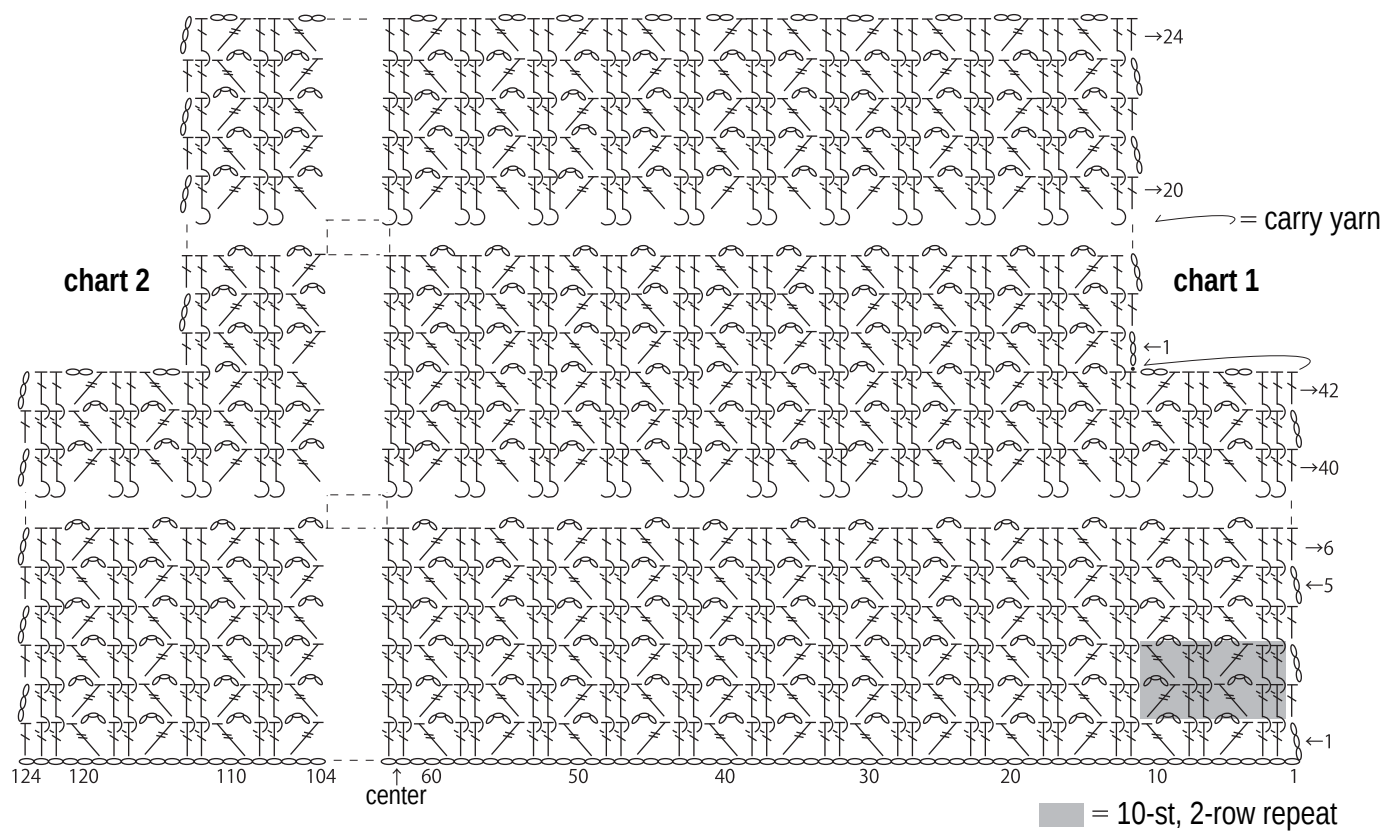


Diagram illustrating the dimensions and construction of a hat pattern:
