## 178pull Short Sleeve Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Cotton [100% cotton; 416 yds/380m per 3.53 oz./100g cone];
  - color #22 saffron, 2 cones [200g]
  - color #24 corn yellow, 2 cones [200g]

### **Tools/Notions:**

 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

#### Finished measurements:

- bust 110cm/43.31"
- center back neck-to-cuff 47.5cm/18.70"
- back length 52.5cm/20.67"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• stockinette stitch: 21 sts and 26 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

### Summary

Note: entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of color #22 & 1 strand of color #24).

**Front & back body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then continue in st st. Place markers for sleeves where indicated on schematics.

**Sleeve (make 2):** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around armhole; work sleeve in st st and then in k2p2 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

**Finishing:** Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam each side of body from hem to cuff with one continuous mattress stitch seam.

#### Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

p = purl

pm = place marker


PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

st st = stockinette stitch

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
