

387pul Brise Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Brise [69% rayon, 20% ramie, 11% polyester; 98 yds/90m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #08 pearl grey, 8 skeins [220g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.3mm (approx. US 3) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 7 buttons (18mm/0.71")

Finished measurements:

- bust 120cm/47.24"
- back length 52.5cm/20.67"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 27 sts and 40 rows
- pattern stitch B: 27 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Right & left back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in pattern stitch A. Make second back piece in mirror image (see schematics).

Front: Start as for back. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Continue in st st, pattern stitch A, and pattern stitch B (see schematic).

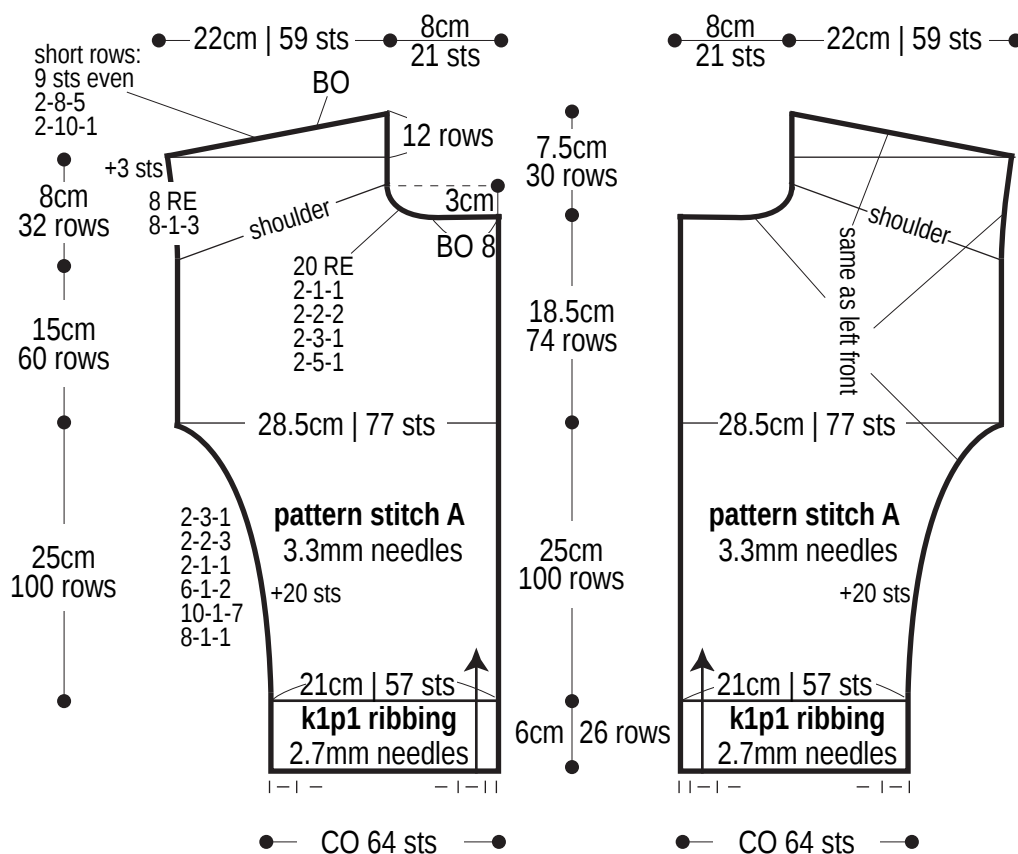
Finishing: Pick up stitches along back edges (center of back) and work buttonband in k1p1 ribbing (work buttonholes in right buttonband only). Bind off in pattern. Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline and cuffs, respectively; work edging in k1p1 ribbing. Work buttonholes on right side of neckline only. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
p = purl
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
st st = stockinette stitch
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

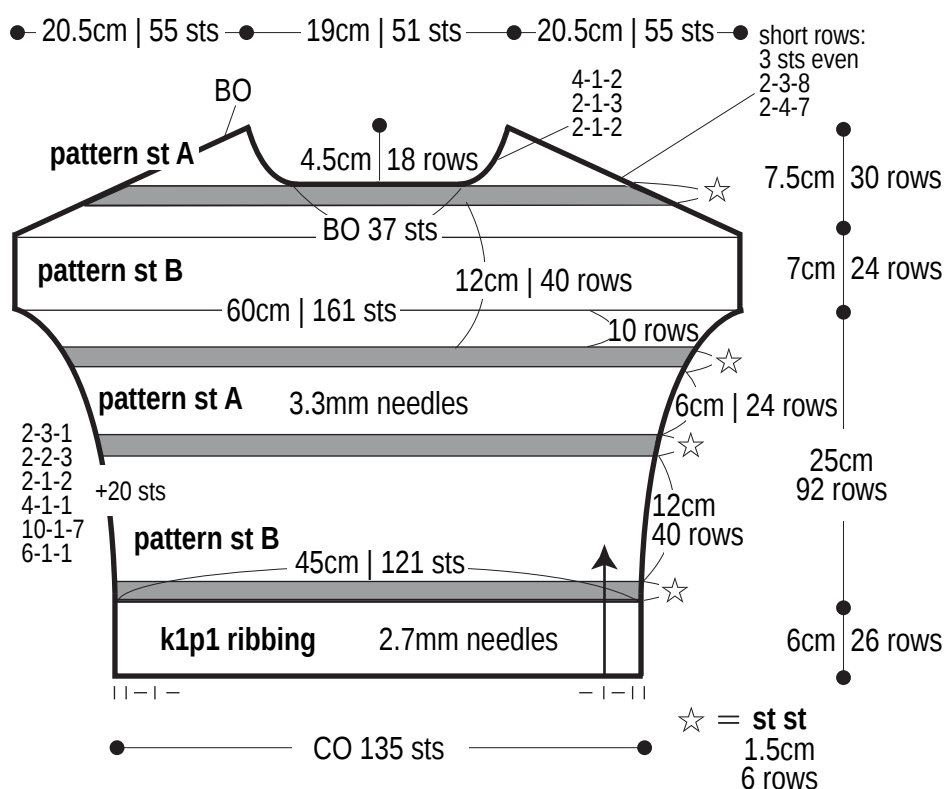
Left back

Right back

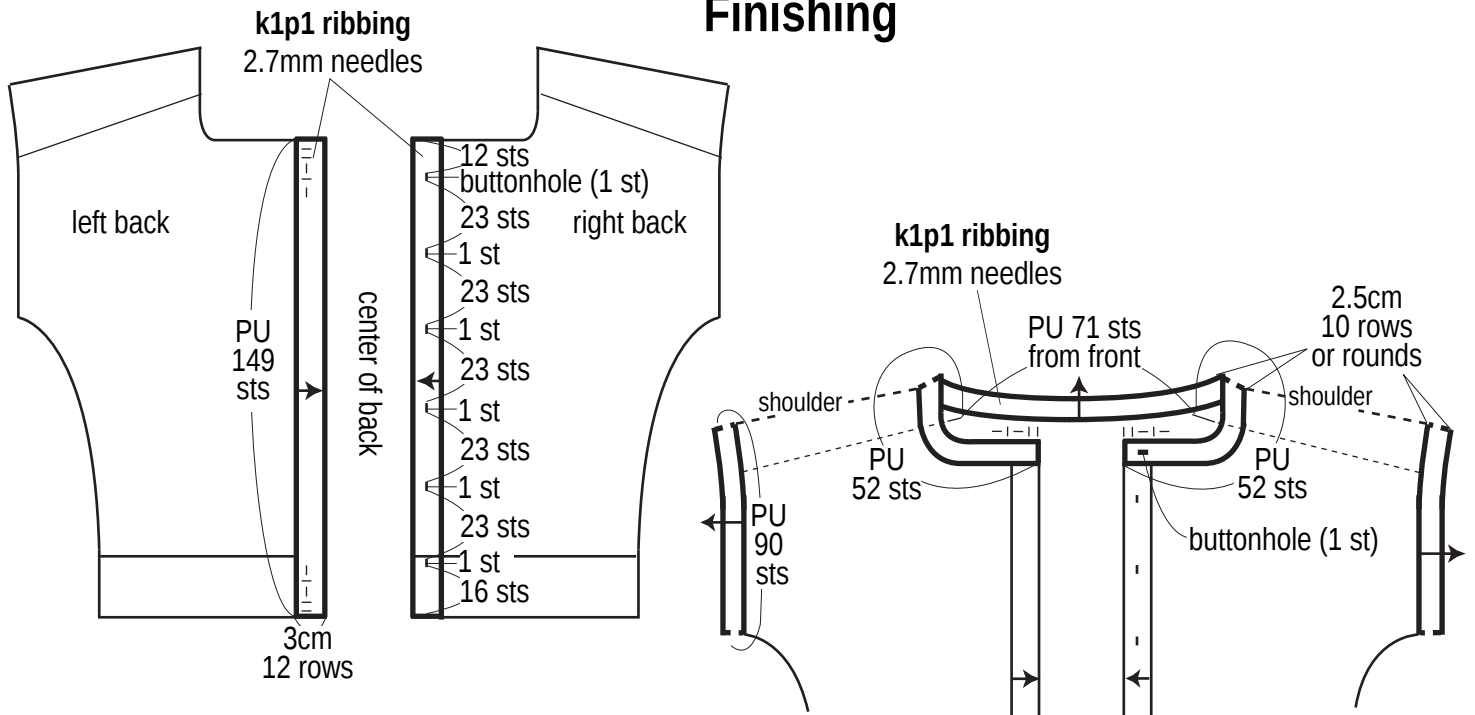


※For increases at sides of work, if increasing just 1 stitch, use a lifted increase at the edge of row. If increasing by 2 or more stitches, use a backwards loop cast-on increase.

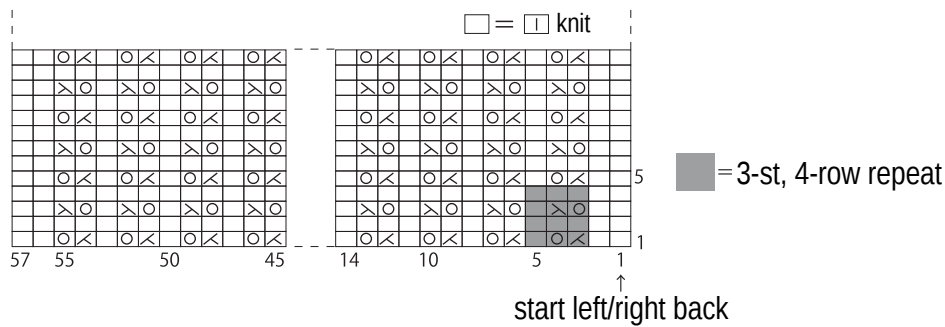

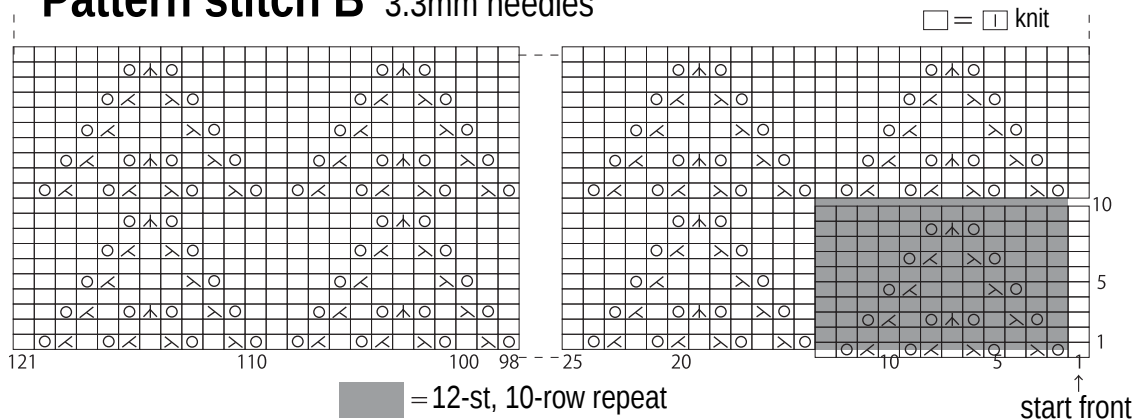
