# 612hbag Heart Shoulder Bag



## Suggested yarn:

 Pierrot Yarns Amian [100% Japanese paper (cellulose); 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./ 40g skein]; color #23 poppy red, 3 skeins [90g]

### **Tools/Notions:**

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- chain for purse strap (90cm/35.43")
- · magnetic clasp

### **Finished measurements:**

• Please see finishing schematic.

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• single crochet (US): 16 sts and 17 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

## **Summary**

\*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

**Sides of bag:** Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch in the round.

Gusset: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc.


**Finishing:** Seam sides to gusset with wrong sides facing each other using sc seam (that is, work sc through both layers of fabric). Attach chain for shoulder strap. Attach magnetic clasp.








## Gusset
