

# 902sh Linen Shawl



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pont du Gard [100% French linen; 188 yds/172m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #14 gris, 5 skeins [195g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- width 30cm/11.81"
- length 154cm/60.63"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 43 sts and 8.5 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

❖ **Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

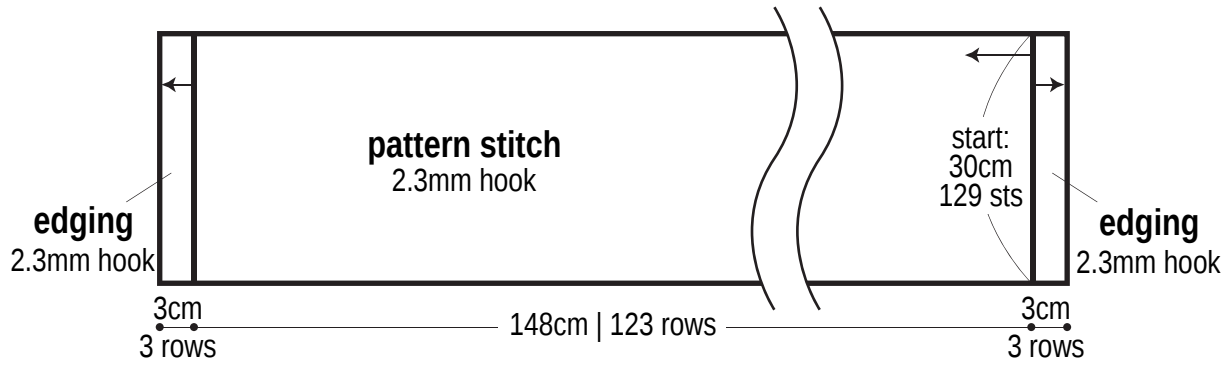
Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch. After last row, continue to edging. After first section of edging is complete, join yarn to foundation chain edge and work edging along that edge.

ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)
