

218aw-09 Kids' Nuage Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Nuage [98% merino wool, 2% cashmere; 44 yds/40m per 2.47 oz./70g skein]; color #01 ivory white, 5 skeins [300g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) and 4.8mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- chest 74cm/29.13"
- center back neck-to-cuff 55cm/21.65"
- back length 37cm/14.57"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 17 sts and 25 rows
- pattern stitch: 19 sts and 24 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing, then for body (back & front), continue in st st. For sleeves, continue in pattern stitch. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases (worked 2 sts in from the edge).

Finishing: Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Graft underarm gusset with Kitchener stitch. Starting at hem edge of side, seam side with mattress stitch all the way up to underarm and then continue to sleeve all the way to cuff. Repeat with other side. Pick up stitches around neckline; work k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.


Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even st st = stockinette stitch #-#-# = rows-stitches-times


Back


Right sleeve




※Reverse shaping for left sleeve.

Collar


k2p2 ribbing

Right sleeve pattern stitch




5-st, 3-row bobble
