

218aw-19 Hedgehog Tissue Cover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% extra fine merino wool; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #227 vanilla beige, 2 skeins [60g]
 - color #228 smoke brown, 4 skeins [115g]
 - color #229 brown, 3 skeins [80g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- approximately 30g/1 oz. polyfiber stuffing
- 2 black safety eyes (11.5mm/0.45" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- Please refer to schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook size necessary to achieve desired fabric stiffness.

Summary

❖**Note 1:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

❖**Note 2:** Entire item worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Head: Work magic ring to begin, then work sc in the round. Insert stuffing as you work. After working last round, cut yarn tail & thread through all remaining stitches; cinch top shut.

Front & back paws: Work magic ring to begin, then work sc in the round.

Ears: Work magic ring to begin, then work pattern stitch in the round.

Torso (belly): Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc in the round, increasing as indicated.

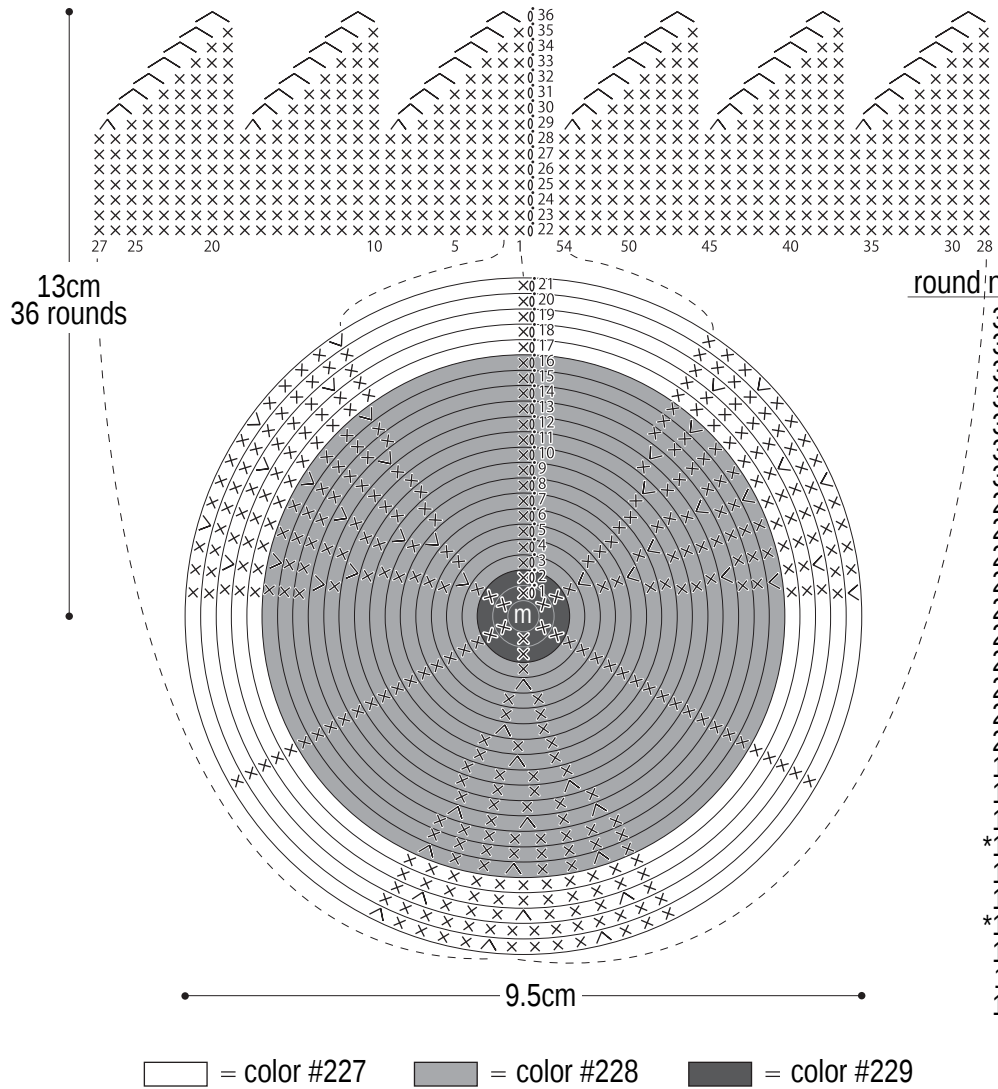
Torso (back): To begin, work pattern stitch in the round into belly piece's foundation chain. Continue working back piece in the round according to chart & schematic (pattern stitch, sc through back loop only, and sc). Insert stuffing as you work. Seam to belly piece by working sts of round 17 of back piece to last round of belly piece.

Finishing: Cut loops of loop sc. Seam ears to head. Fasten safety eyes to head. Seam head, front paws, and back paws to torso. Make fringe & attach to head.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain m = magic ring/circle RS = right side sc = single crochet (US) WS = wrong side

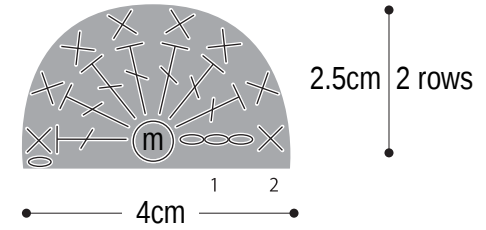
Face 4.0mm hook

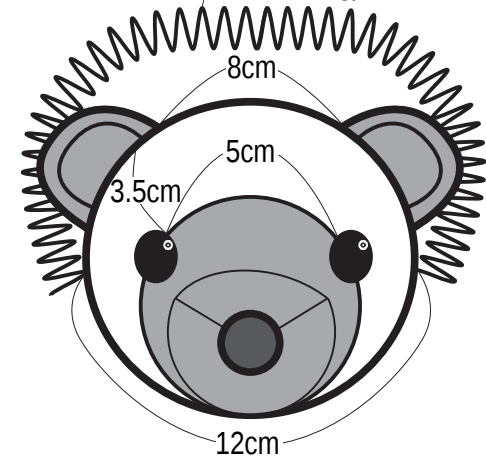
Ear (make 2)

After sewing face/head to body, make fringe (2 strands of yarn 8cm long) and attach to head.



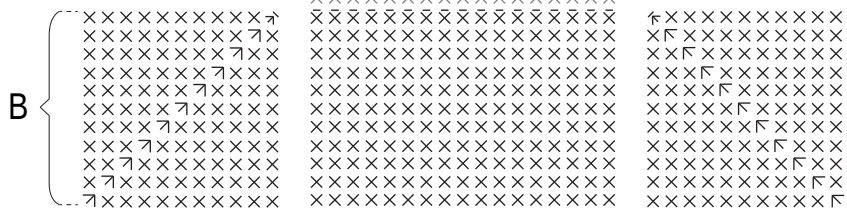
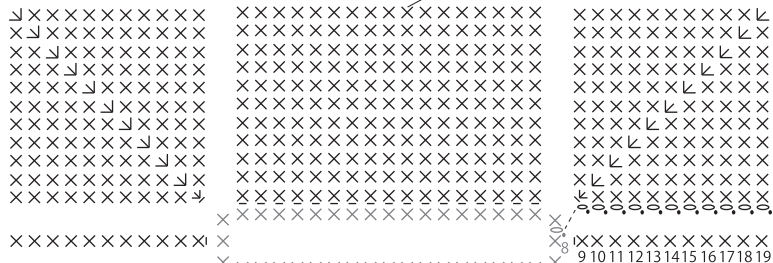
Torso (belly side)

rounds 1-8

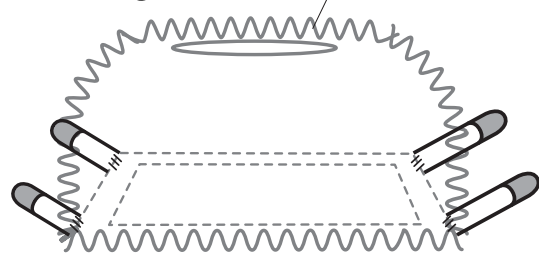
rounds 1-8: work even in the round

Finishing

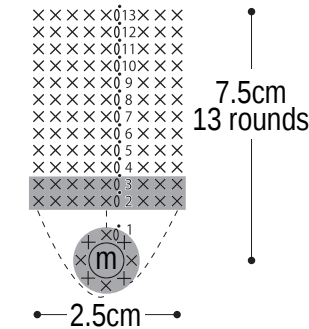
Cut the center of the loops.



Whipstitch paws to corners of body.

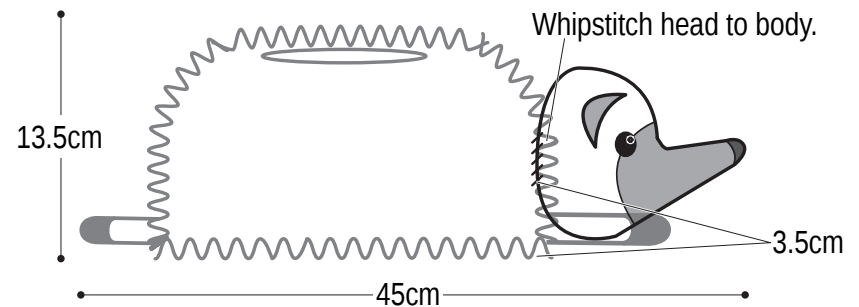
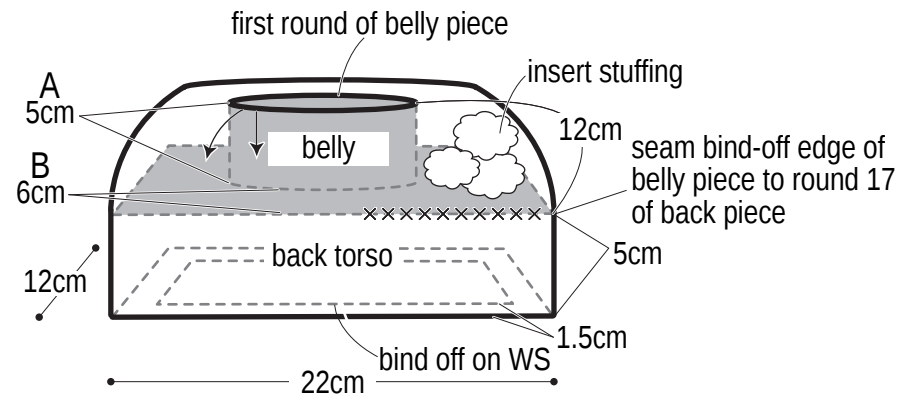
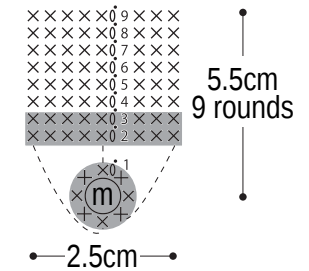

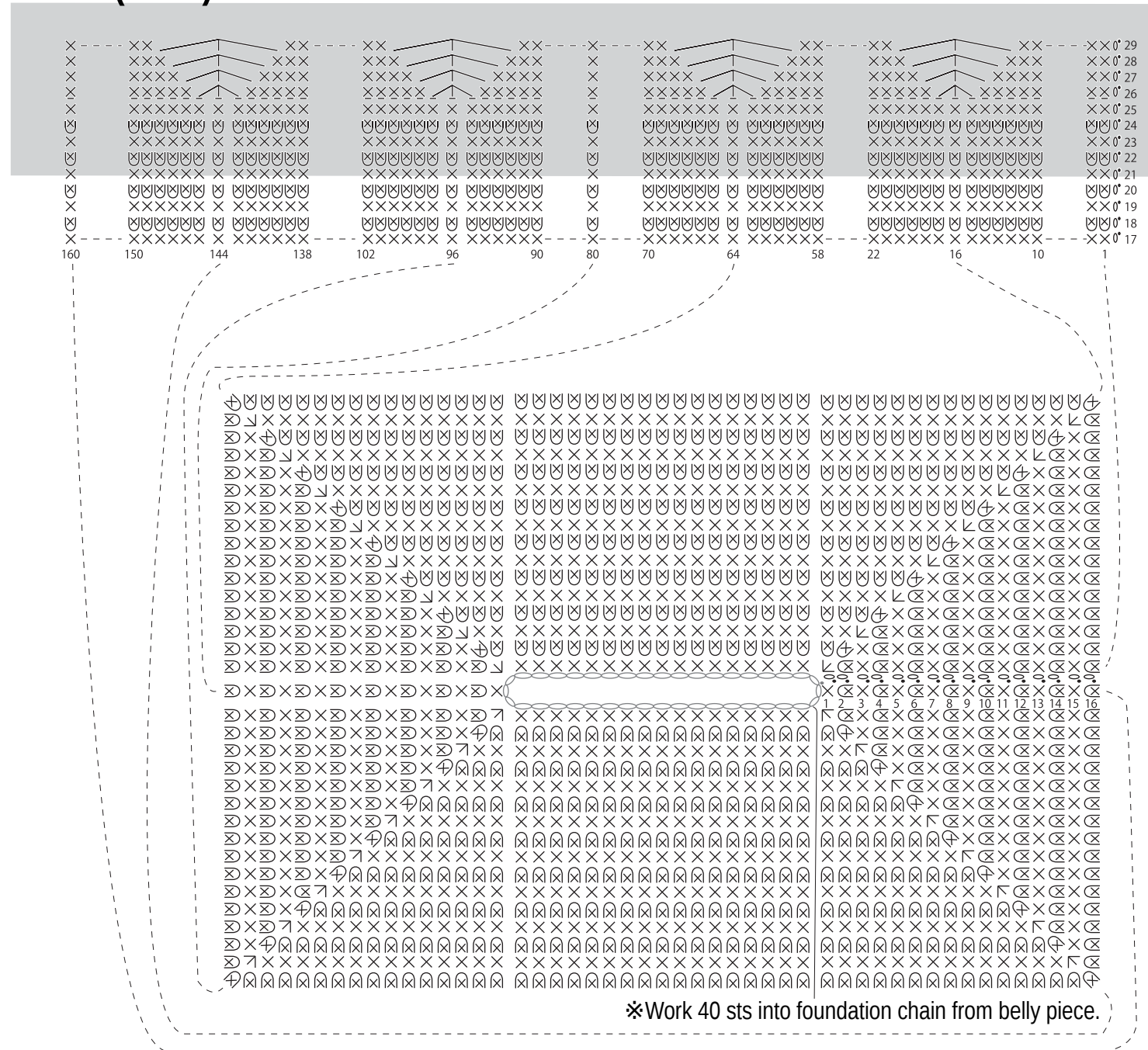


Back paw

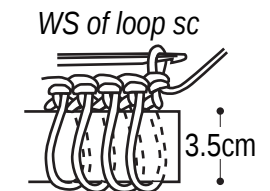
Torso (back) 4.0mm hook

※While working round 17, insert stuffing. Seam belly & back together by working sts of this round together with sts of last round of belly piece.

2 strands (colors 228 & 229)



※Wrap yarn around piece of cardboard 3.5cm wide (instead of using finger) to work loop sc.
