# 218aw-20 Rabbit



#### Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Loiseau Bleu [100% merino wool; 79 yds/72m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #02 ivory, 2 skeins [70g]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 safety eyes (8mm/0.31")
- small amount polyfiber stuffing
- yellow felt (1.5cm/0.59" by 3cm/1.18")
- yellow sewing thread
- piece of pink yarn for nose (50cm/19.69")

#### **Finished measurements:**

• Please refer to finishing schematic.

### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• No gauge information provided in the original pattern. Use hook size necessary to achieve desired fabric thickness & drape.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### Summary

\*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Head: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc in the round, increasing and decreasing as indicated in chart.


Body, arms, legs, ears & tail: Work magic ring to begin, then work in sc in the round, increasing and decreasing as indicated in chart.

Finishing: Insert stuffing into each body part. Seam parts together using whipstitch (see finishing schematic). Fasten safety eyes to head. Embroider nose and mouth. Make a bow out of felt and fasten to the base of one ear as shown in finishing schematic.







\*Insert stuffing into each body part, then seam together with whipstitch. We recommend filling ear and arm pieces only halfway.
