

218aw-16 Pocket Scarf



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Basic Bulky [100% merino wool; 49 yds/45m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #35 monochrome, 12 skeins [480g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) and 7.0mm (no close US equivalent) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 25.5cm/10"
- length (not including fringe) 226cm/89"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- seed stitch: 12 sts and 20.5 rows
- reverse stockinette stitch: 12.5 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body of scarf: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in seed stitch, then bind off.

Pocket (make 2): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in reverse st st and k1p1 ribbing as indicated in schematic. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam each pocket to scarf where indicated in schematic using whipstitch. Make fringe and attach to cast-on edge and bind-off edge of scarf.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

p = purl

st st = stockinette stitch
