218w-01 Dolman Sweater



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Pure Wool Lace / Junmo Gokuboso [50% merino wool, 50% wool; 820 yds/750m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #801 off-white, 1 cone [90g]
Pierrot Yarns Whips [58% acrylic, 30% nylon, 12% wool; 175 yds/160m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #06 raw gray, 3 skeins [195g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) and 5.7mm (approx. US 9) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.5mm (approx. US ???) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 71cm/27.95"
- back length 54.5cm/21.46"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 13.5 sts and 21 rows
- pattern stitch B: 16.5 sts and 21 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


*Note: Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Junmo Gokuboso and 1 strand of Whips).

Body (1 back, 1 front): With crochet hook, make 4 separate chains 37 chain sts long; set aside for later. With knitting needles, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Referring to chart and schematics, work in pattern stitches A & B. Pick up stitches along cast-on edge; work k1p1 ribbing and then bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeves with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Pick up stitches around each cuff edge; work cuff in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain st CO = cast on k = knit p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
