

tricot5-6 Miniature Accessories



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Grayish Ramie [77% rayon, 23% ramie; 164 yds/150m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - **bag:** color #33 dark wisteria, 1 skein [5g]
 - **ice cream:**
 - color #31 off-white, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #33 dark wisteria, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #37 biscuit, 1 skein [small amount]
 - **hat:** color #37 biscuit, 1 skein [5g]
 - **goat:**
 - color #31 off-white, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #33 dark wisteria, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #37 biscuit, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- **bag:** 1 piece of lace ribbon, 1cm/0.39" wide and 13cm/5.12" long
- **ice cream:**
 - small amount pink embroidery thread
 - small amount polyfiber stuffing
- **hat:** 1 piece of lace ribbon, 1cm/0.39" wide and 13cm/5.12" long
- **goat:**
 - 2 safety eyes (4mm/0.16" diameter)
 - 1 bead (4mm/0.16" diameter)
 - small amount black embroidery thread
 - small amount polyfiber stuffing

Finished measurements:

- Please see schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook size necessary to achieve desired fabric density & drape.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Bag: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in sc and sc tbl. Crochet handles and seam to bag where indicated in finishing schematic. Sew lace ribbon to bag in 4 places indicated in finishing schematic.

Ice cream: Work magic ring to begin, then work in sc in the round. Insert stuffing into cone and scoops A & B, then seam together with whipstitch as indicated in finishing schematic. Embroider scoops A & B with pink embroidery thread.

Hat: Work magic ring to begin, then work in sc and sc tbl in the round. Sew lace ribbon to hat as indicated in finishing schematic.


Goat: For head, torso, and horns, begin with magic ring, then work in sc. For legs, begin with magic ring and work in sc tbl. Insert stuffing into each piece. On last rounds of head and torso, respectively, cut yarn and thread tail through all remaining stitches; cinch piece shut. For ears, work foundation chain, then work in sc. Crochet beard onto face using chain st and slip st as shown in chart on face finishing schematic. Seam all parts together with whipstitch as shown in finishing schematics. Attach safety eyes and embroider nose and mouth as shown in finishing schematics. Work collar in chain st, attaching a bead as shown in chart. Fasten collar around goat's neck.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain m = magic ring/circle sc = single crochet (US) tbl = through back loop only

✳️Use 2.3mm hook for everything.











Bag finishing




Ice cream finishing








Leg (make 4)




Collar

color #33 dark wisteria




Thread bead onto yarn or embroidery thread, then work bead into sixth chain st. Chain color of collar if desired.

Finishing: face




Ear (make 2)

 * Where color is not marked, use color #31 off-white.

Nose & mouth embroidery: with black embroidery thread, take needle out at 1, in at 2, out at 3, in at 4, out at 5, catch the thread between 3 and 4, and finally back in at 6.


