218aw-06 Nimes Oversized Pullover



Suggested yarn:

• Pierrot Yarns Nimes M [70% alpaca, 30% nylon; 101 yds/92m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #17 gray, 18 skeins [440g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US 10) and 6.6mm (approx. US 101/2) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.0mm (US J) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 71cm/28.0"
- back length 63.5cm/25.0"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 14 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


❖Note: entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body: Before starting to knit, crochet 4 chains (each 21 sts long) and save for later, where they will be used for the sleeves. With knitting needles, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch.


Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeves with one continuous mattress stitch seam per side of body/sleeve. Pick up stitches around cuff and hem edges, respectively; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain stitch CO = cast on k = knit k3tog = knit 3 sts together p = purl PU = pick up RE = row(s) even YO = yarn over #-# = rows-stitches-times




Front neckline




*Other than the neckline shaping, the front should be worked the same as the back.
