

# 218aw-08 Leclair Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Leclair [70% merino wool, 30% lamb's wool; 39 yds/36m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #01 milky white, 15 skeins [600g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) and 8.0mm (US 11) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.0"
- center back neck-to-cuff 73.5cm/28.9"
- back length 50cm/19.7"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- garter stitch: 11 sts and 23 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Body (make 2):** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in garter stitch. Bind off. Pick up stitches along hem edge; work hem welt in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

**Sleeve (make 2):** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in garter stitch, increasing and decreasing as indicated. Bind off. Pick up stitches along cuff edge; work cuff in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

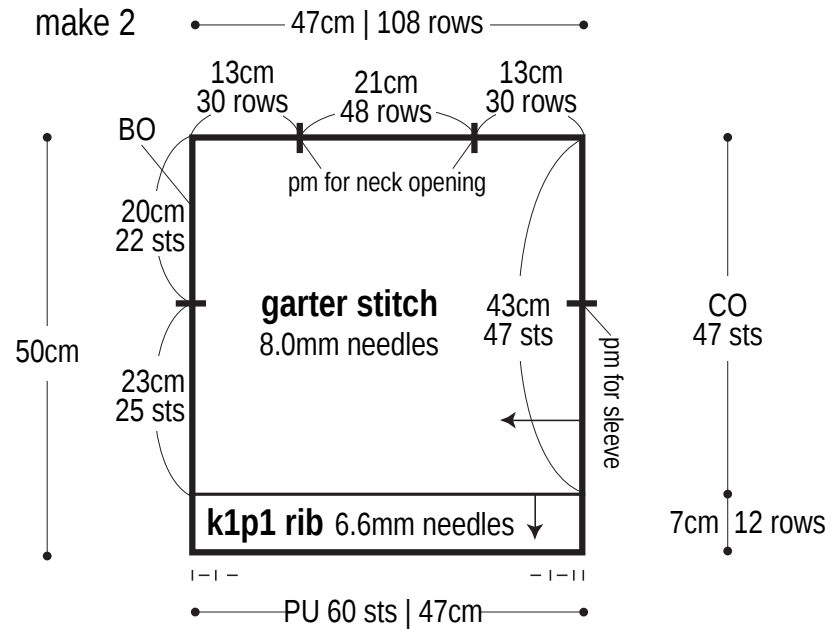
**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. On each side of body, seam side and sleeve with one continuous whipstitch seam.

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off    CO = cast on    k = knit    p = purl    pm = place marker    PU = pick up    #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

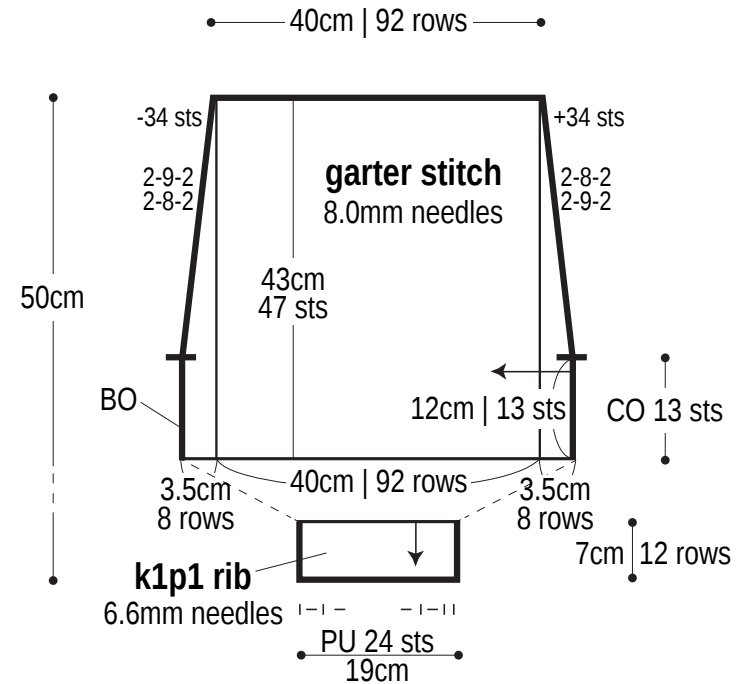
## Body

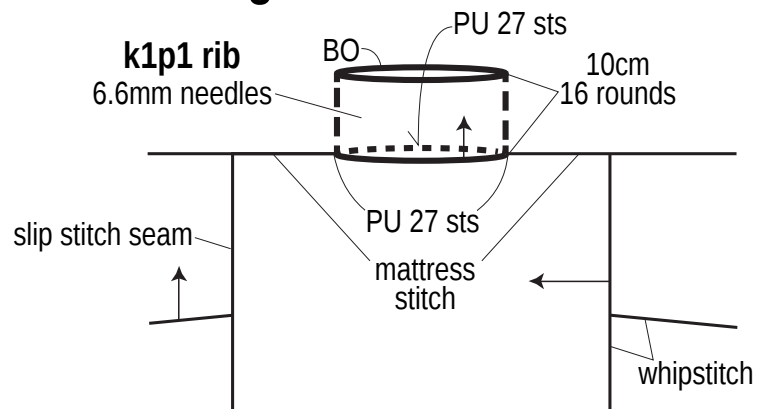


## Sleeve
