218w-04 Simple Garter Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Nuage [98% merino wool, 2% cashmere; 77 yds/70m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #09 sand beige, 13 skeins [520g]
 - color #11 burgundy, 14 skeins [560g]

Tools/Notions:

- small: 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.8mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- medium: 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- · small:
 - bust 90cm/35.4"
 - center back neck-to-cuff 69.5cm/27.3"
 - back length 55.5cm/21.8"

- medium:
 - bust 100cm/39.4"
 - center back neck-to-cuff 77cm/30.3"
 - back length 62cm/24.4"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- small: garter stitch: 18.5 sts and 31 rows
- medium: garter stitch: 16.5 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in garter stitch.

Sleeve: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches along armscye (between markers and shoulder seam); work sleeve in garter stitch and then in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam each side of body/sleeve with one continuous mattress stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on k = knit p = purl pm = place marker PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times
