

1202cd-muf Hana Merino Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Hana Merino [100% merino wool; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #27 winter blue, 10 skeins [380g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5), 3.9mm (approx. US 6), and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 buttons (18mm/0.7")

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.0"
- center back neck-to-cuff (excluding rolled edge) 72.5cm/28.5"
- back length 59cm/23.2"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 18 sts and 25 rows
- pattern stitch: 23 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

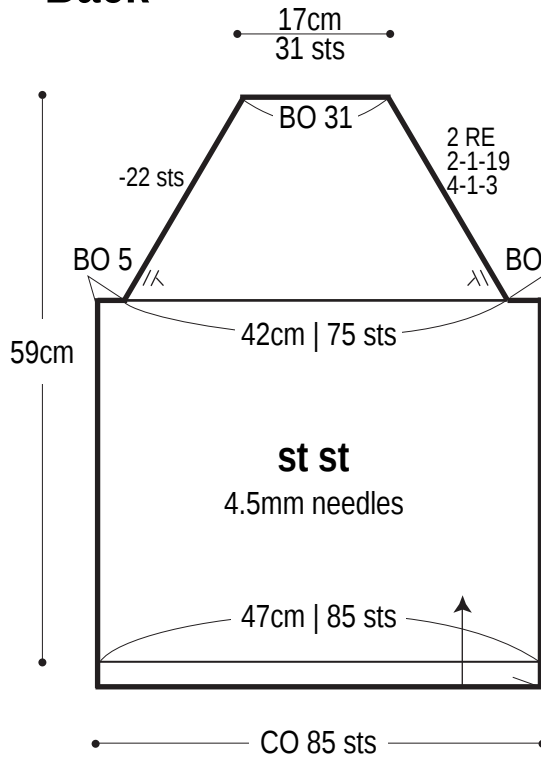
Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in st st. Change needle size, then continue working in st st. Shape raglan edges by working fully fashioned decreases (worked 2 sts in from the edge). Allow hem and cuff edges to roll.

Finishing: Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches from body and sleeves; work buttonband/collar in pattern stitch and then in st st. Bind off. Seam underarm gusset with Kitchener stitch. Seam sides and sleeves with mattress stitch (one continuous seam per sleeve/side of body). Seam center back of collar with mattress stitch.

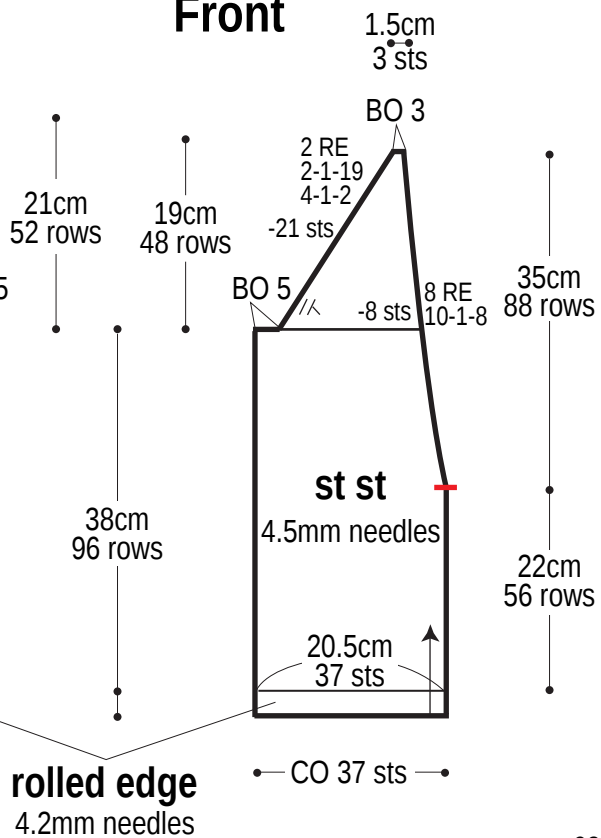
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
st st = stockinette stitch
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

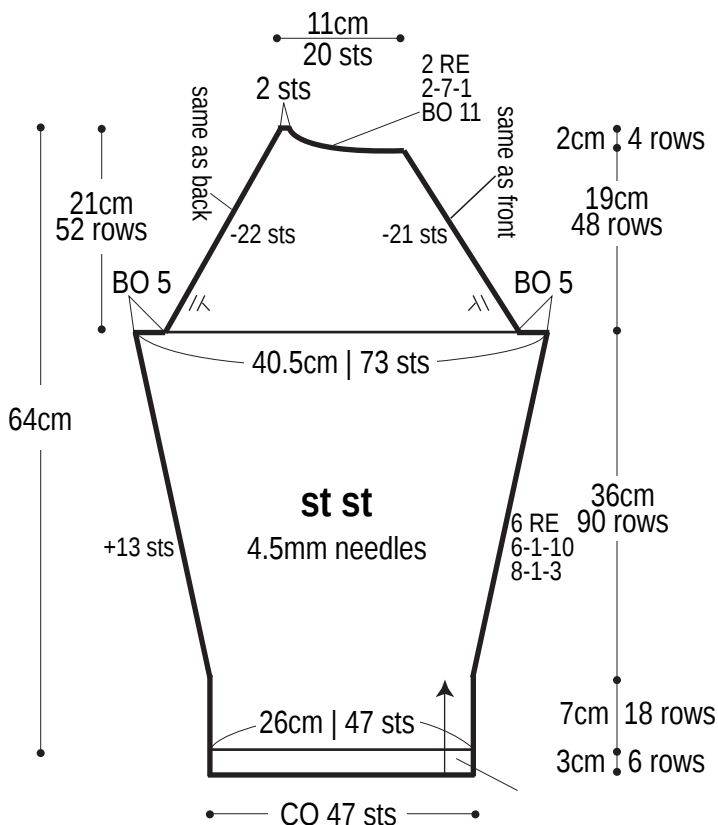
Back

Right sleeve



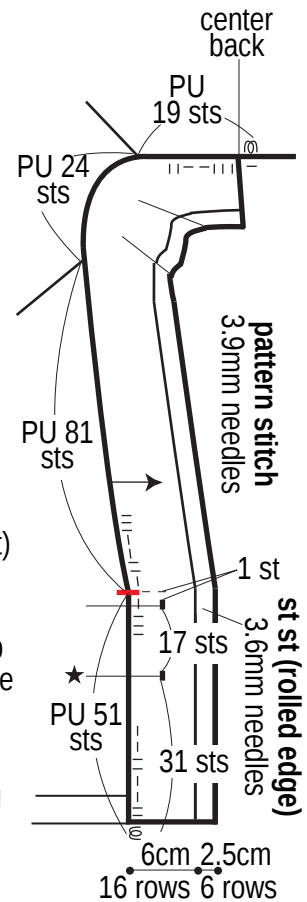
Right front buttonband & collar

★ = buttonhole (1 st)

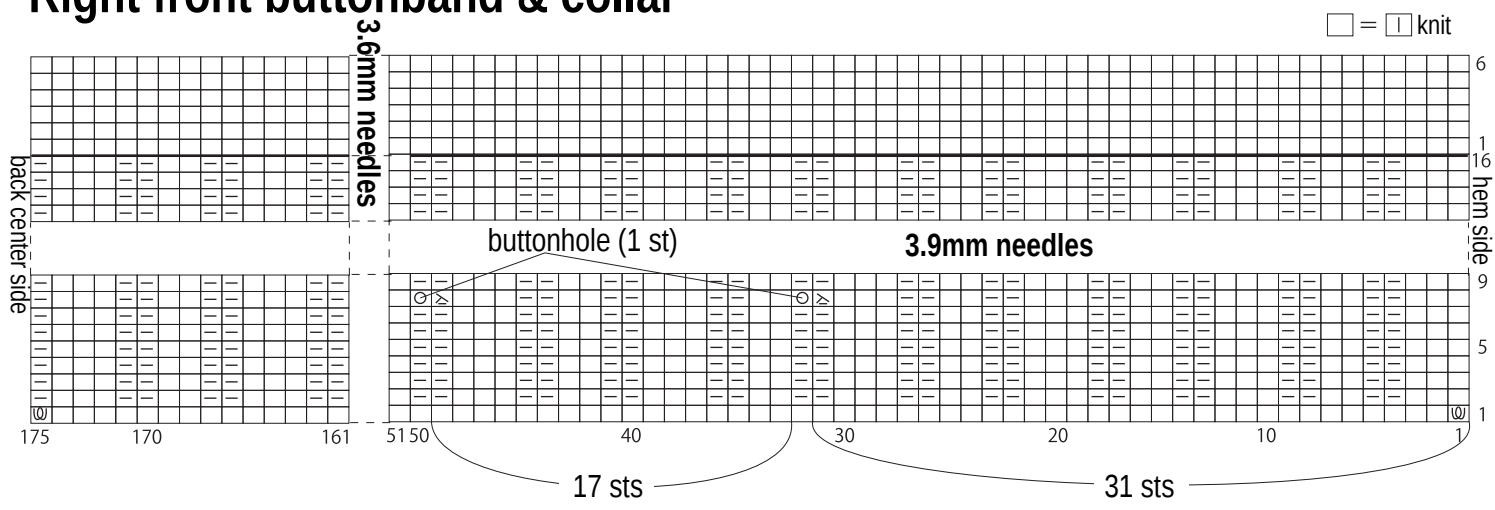
☐ = backwards loop cast-on increase
