

1245sh Triangular Shawl



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pousse [70% rayon, 30% merino wool; 141 yds/129m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #01 purple, 6 skeins [210g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- length 194cm/76.4"
- width 46cm/18.1"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 25 sts and 10.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Body of shawl: Work magic ring to begin, then work shawl in pattern stitches A & B according to chart, increasing and decreasing as indicated.

Finishing: Work 1 row of edging.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

m = magic ring/circle

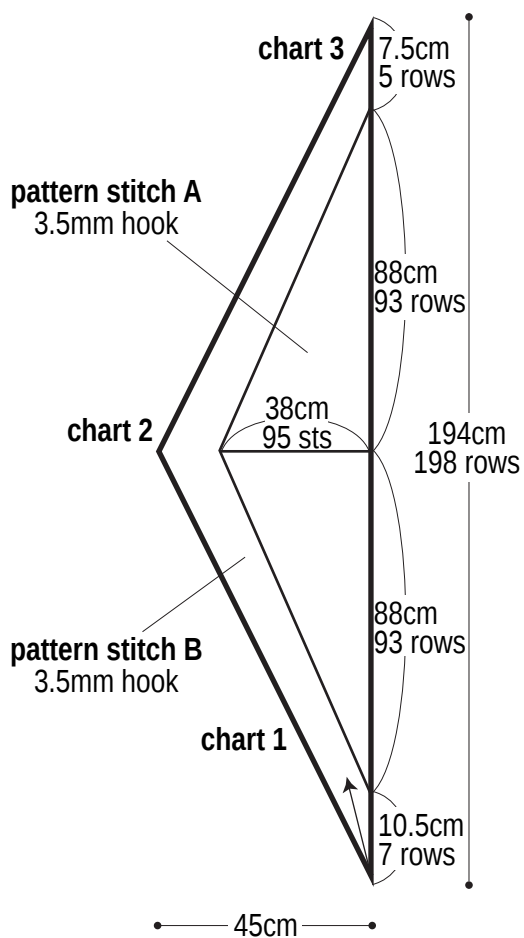


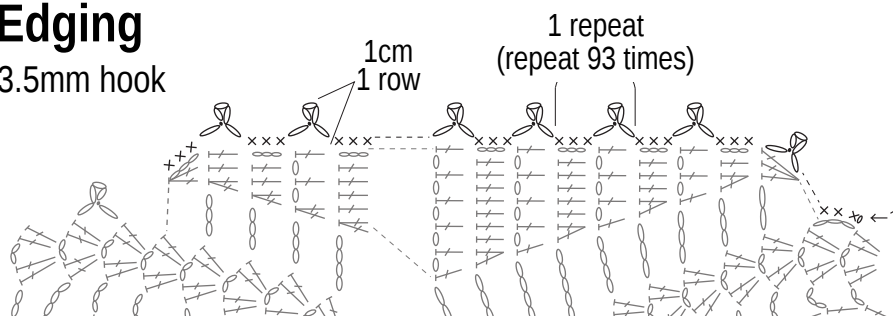
