

5vest Mix Pattern Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso / Pure Wool Fingering [40% merino wool, 60% punta wool; 164 yds/150m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #401 white, 2 skeins [65g]
 - color #415 black, 1 skein [25g]
 - color #434 apricot, 2 skeins [50g]
 - color #437 royal blue, 3 skeins [90g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) & 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.2"
- cross back width 37cm/14.6"
- back length 48cm/18.9"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 19 sts and 22 rows
- pattern stitch: 20 sts and 31.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note:** With the exception of the crocheted side slit edging, the entire garment is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, pattern stitch, and st st according to schematics.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides from underarm to where end of side slit is marked on schematic. Pick up stitches around neckline and armholes, respectively; work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Crochet edging along sides slits (see schematic) with 1 strand of yarn.

Abbreviations:

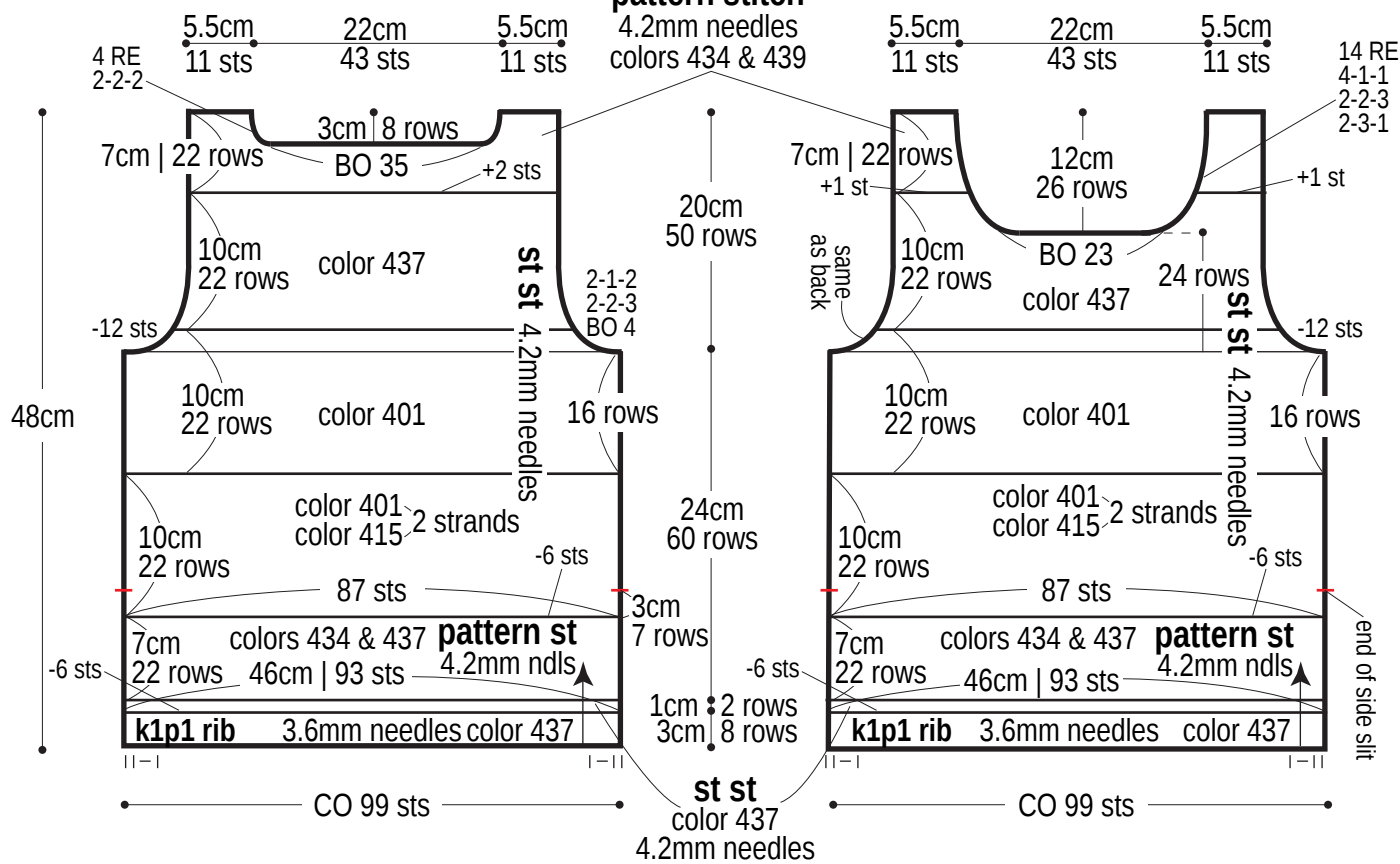
BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
p = purl
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
st st = stockinette stitch
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

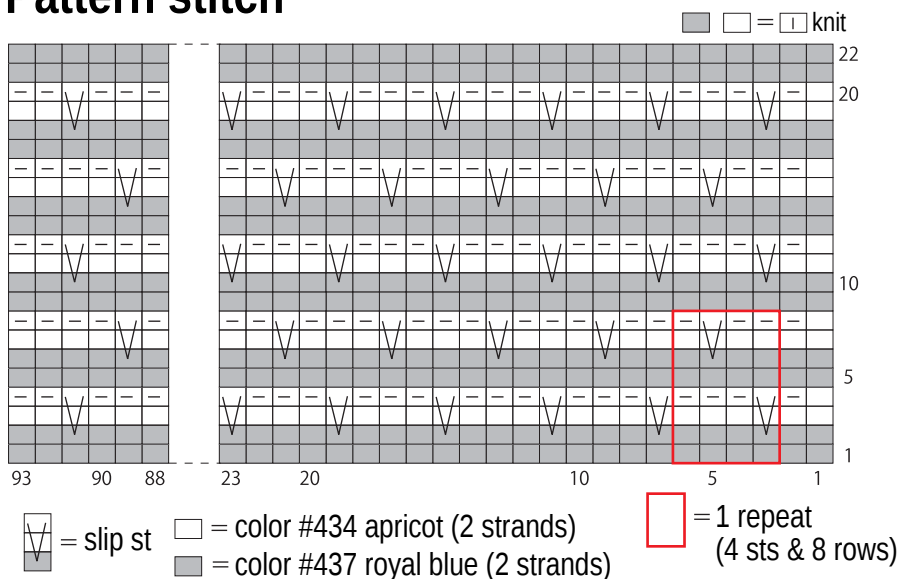

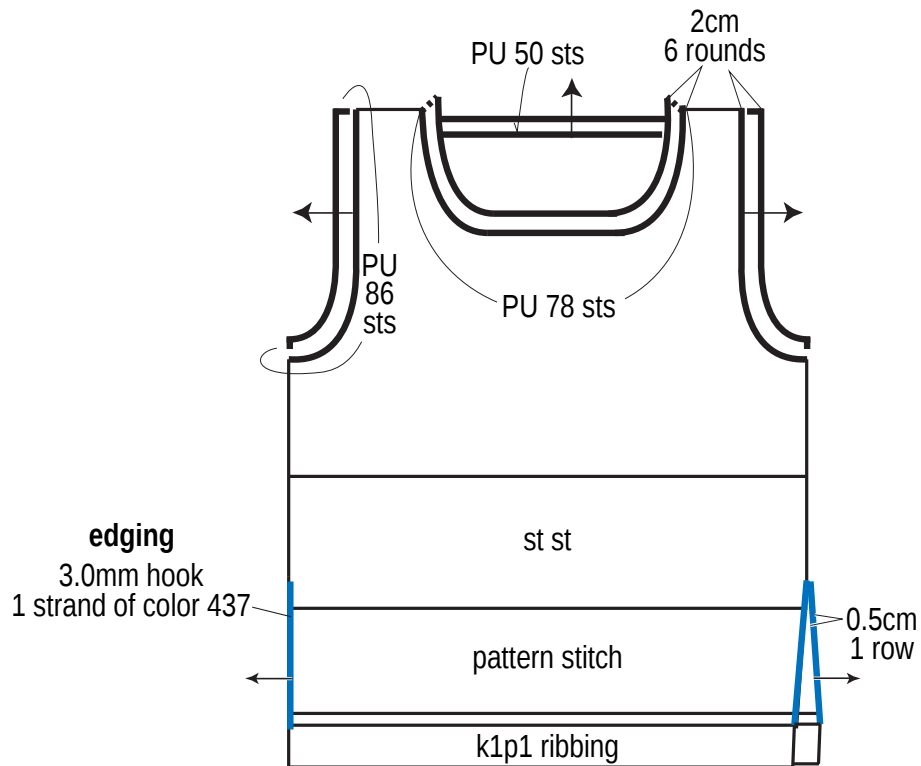
color 401: white
