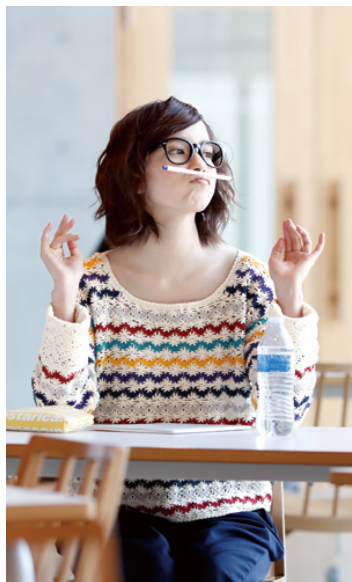


# 219ss-03 Striped Sweater



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Ethnic Denim 2 [100% cotton; 118 yds/108m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
  - color #01 off white, 10 skeins [285g]
  - color #07 emerald green, 1 skein [30g]
  - color #08 navy, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #11 mustard, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #13 violet, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #16 light gray, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #18 dark red, 1 skein [25g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 100cm/39.4"
- center back neck-to-cuff (when cuffs are folded up) 76.5cm/30.1"
- back length 49cm/19.3"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 2.5mm hook): 30 sts and 15 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

**Body (back & front):** Work foundation chain to begin, then work stripes in pattern stitch.

**Sleeve (make 2):** Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch and striped pattern stitch. When finished, join yarn to foundation edge and work cuff in pattern stitch.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides and sleeve undersides with chain seam. Seam folded cuff with chain seam from right side. Seam sleeves to body with ladder stitch. Crochet edging in the round along neckline, hem, and cuff edges, respectively.

## Abbreviations:

ch = chain      dc = double crochet (US)      dc4tog = work 4 dc sts together      pm = place marker(s)

**Finishing**

**Collar and Shoulder Details:**

- Collar Edging:** 2.5mm hook, 1cm, 3 rounds.
- Collar Stitches:** 62 sts (top), 104 sts (bottom).
- Shoulder Edging:** 3.0mm hook, 1cm, 3 rounds.
- Shoulder Stitches:** 78 sts.
- Shoulder Seam:** ladder stitch.
- Chain Seam:** chain seam.

**Side Panel Details:**

- Side Panel Edging:** 2.5mm hook, 1cm, 3 rounds.
- Side Panel Stitches:** 260 sts.

3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 11 mustard
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 13 violet
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 08 navy
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 16 gray
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 18 red
2 rows	color 01 off white

✱Always carry color 01 (do not cut). For all other colors, cut when finished with a row & begin on right side.

 = shell stitch



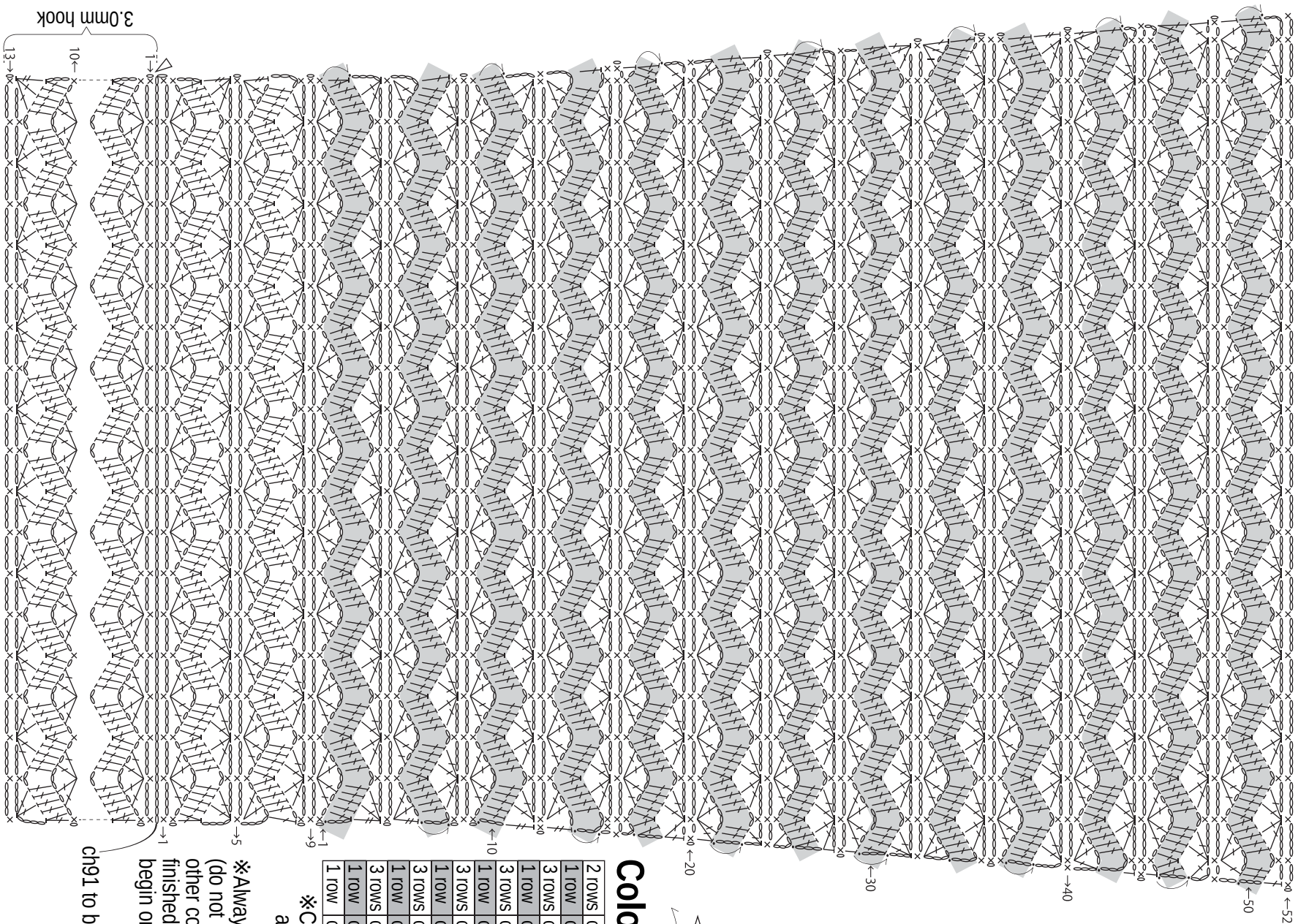

1 row	color 11 mustard
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 13 violet
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 08 navy
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 16 gray
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 18 red
3 rows	color 01 off white
1 row	color 07 emerald green
1 row	color 01 off white

※Color sequence is  
a 24-row repeat.

※Always carry color 01  
(do not cut). For all  
other colors, cut when  
finished with a row &  
begin on right side.
