

1244sw Kushel Premium Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Kushel [70% silk, 30% cashmere; 106 yds/97m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #07 sea green, 11 skeins [335g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 95cm/37.4"
- cross back width 38cm/15.0"
- back length 60cm/23.6"
- sleeve length 53cm/20.9"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 29 sts and 37 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary


Body (front & back) & sleeves: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Remove provisional cast-on edge at hem and cuffs, respectively, picking up the live stitches as you go. Work twisted k2p2 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in twisted k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with one continuous mattress stitch seam per side of body/sleeve. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.


Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- k = knit
- p = purl
- PU = pick up
- RE = row(s) even
- #-#-# = rows-stitches-times


Back




Front

*On right side, the 5 purl stitches (within a single repeat) shift diagonally to the left one step at a time. Repeat diagonally to the left.
