

# tricot13-6 Sophie Bag



## Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Sophie Linen [100% linen; 184 yds/168m per 3.53 oz./100g cone];
  - color #01 ivory, 1 cone [30g]
  - color #11 slate gray, 2 cones [150g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- Please see schematics.

## Gauge:

- garter stitch: 1 motif = 9.5cm/3.7" square

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Body of bag:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work mitered motifs (also known as domino knitting) in garter stitch according to chart & schematic, using center double decreases to shape them. Continue to next motif by picking up stitches and then working motif chart again.

**Finishing:** Work sc edging in the round along mouth of bag. Work two handles in sc and seam to bag.

## Abbreviations:

cdd = center double decrease (specifically, slip 2 sts knitwise, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches over the knit stitch)

ch = chain stitch

CO = cast on

PU = pick up

RS = right side

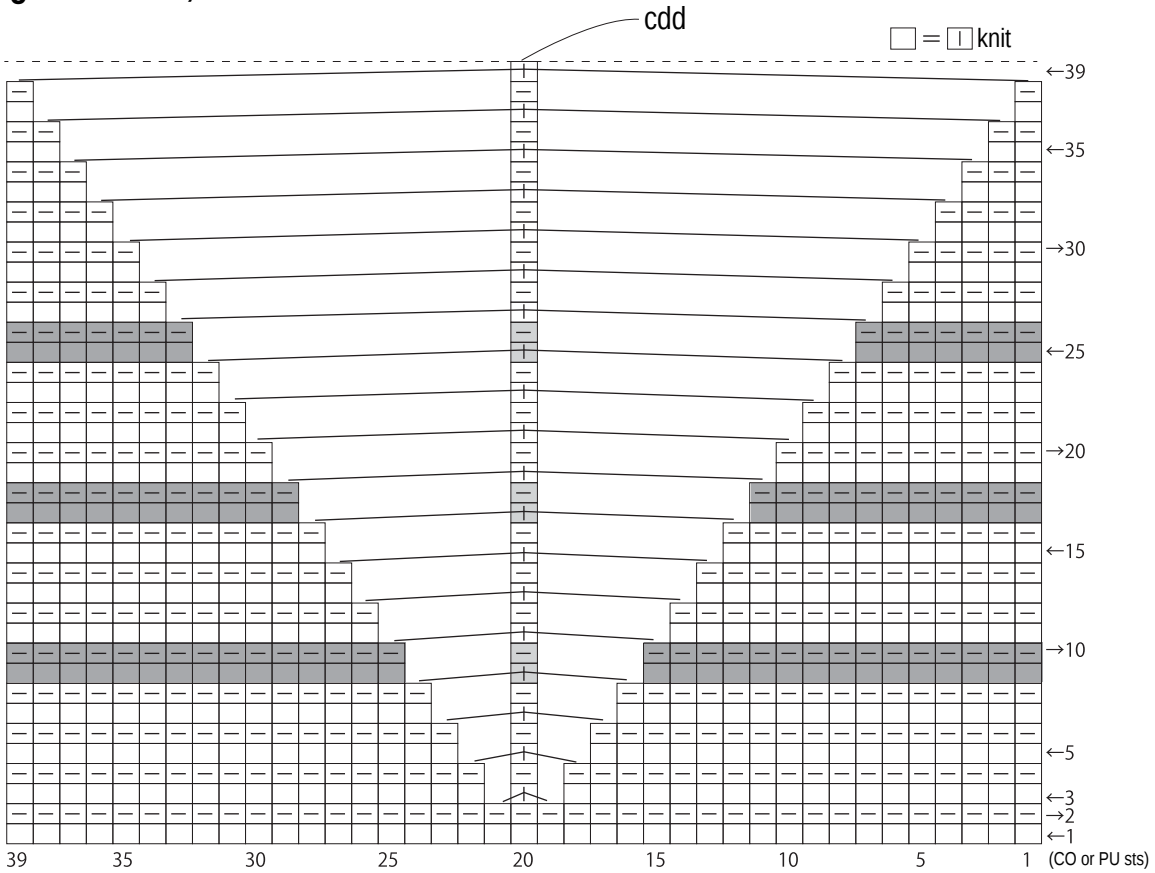
sc = single crochet (US)

sc2tog = work 2 sc together

WS = wrong side

# Motif

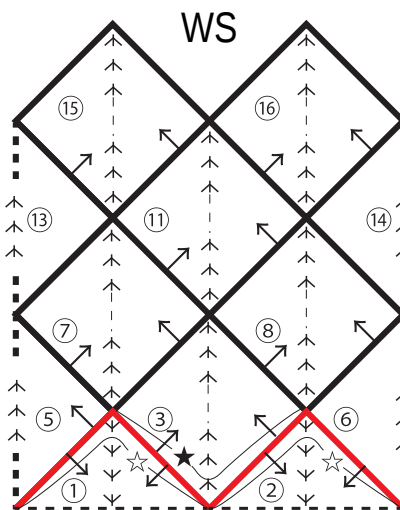
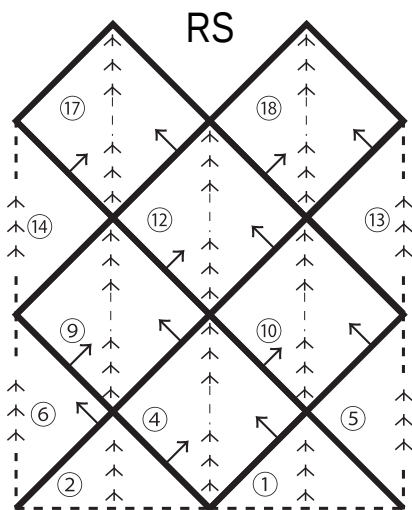
garter stitch, 3.0mm needles



■ = color #01 ivory

※Elsewhere, use color #11 slate gray.

CO 39 sts or PU 39 sts, then work in garter stitch. At center of every odd row, work center double decrease (cdd). Repeat until there is only 1 st remaining.



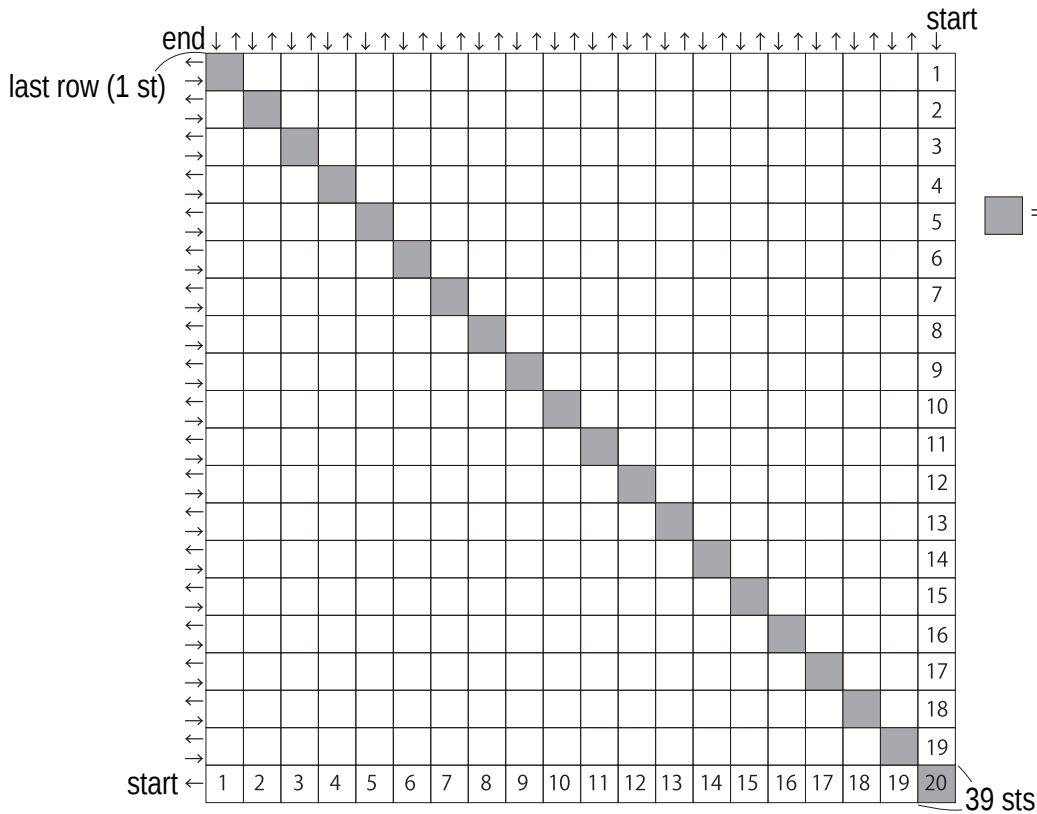
Work two motifs (1 and 2 in schematic). For motifs 3 to 18, instead of casting on new stitches, PU sts from along two sides of previous motif.

(PU 19 sts along each side. Work cdd at center of each motif.)

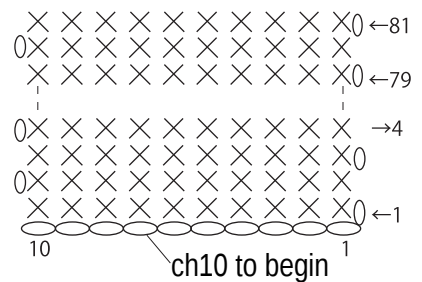
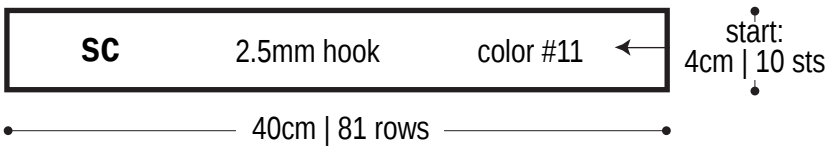
☆ = CO 39 sts
